Armenia

One of the two 350 kW TRAM transmitters, which used to broadcast Europe 1 on longwave from the Saarland in Germany, is back in service. It has been reinstalled at the Noratus station on Lake Sevan in Armenia. The transmitter has been modified by Broadcasting Center Europe to broadcast on medium wave. This TRAM transmitter offers an efficiency close to 100%. Thanks to the modular system, broadcasting continues even when one or more modules fail: power is only reduced by 1 kW per defective module. Modules with a power of 1 kW are grouped together in different cabinets per 50 kW. Modules can be replaced on the fly, without shutting down the transmitter.

The transmitter now broadcasts on 1377 kHz and replaces an old Soviet Borey RV 601 radio transmitter. It is coupled to a KinStar low-profile directional antenna system, built by Kintronic Labs. It allows waves to be sent to azimuths -67, 127 and 247 degrees. (info *Andrei Molokov, the page V contact "Радиорубка. Страницы истории Мощного Радио"*). In the evening, the transmitter broadcasts Trans World Radio programs to Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan and Ukraine.

Australia

Celebrating 50 years since 2JJ launched.

2JJ – Double Jay – was Australia's first non-commercial, 24-hour rock radio station for young people, launching on 1540 kHz AM in Sydney on 19 January 1975. To mark the 50th anniversary of the station's launch, the first 12 hours of 2JJ's day on air now are being rebroadcast on the Double J digital station which is also available online through ABC Listen at <https://www.abc.net.au/listen/doublej>



Poor transmitter quality limited the station's reach across Sydney, and actually led to threats of industrial action by staff. Nothing was done to improve the transmitter until 1980 when the station switched to 105.7 FM and became 2JJJ – Triple J. The station expanded into a national FM network during the 1990s.

Only certain roads within Norfolk Island are covered by Google Map Monkey. There is one section where the 1566 kHz VL2NI mast can be seen in the distance. The VL2NI mast is near some satellite dishes and police station around New Cascade Road. The 1566 kHz TX power output is quite low, effectively 0 as specified by ACMA. This explains why nobody is hearing 1566 kHz via the ionosphere.

While looking around Norfolk Roads, some parts of the world are an absolute eyesore in comparison. Norfolk has escaped high rise real estate development.

China

In mid-December, Chinese DXers reported DRM test transmissions with non-stop Chinese music throughout the day on 1557 kHz. The signal is over Zhongshan City, Guangdong Province, displaying “Drm(GD_ZS)”. “GD” means Guangdong, “ZS” means Zhongshan.

According to other information, DRM broadcasts are also planned in Guangzhou and Huizhou, Guangdong Province, on the same frequency and format 1557 kHz is used by **Radio Taiwan International (RTI)** for its Chinese service to Chinese mainland in the night (over Kouhu transmitter site, 300kW, at 0900-1700 UTC, except 1100-12:00 KBS relay). China has set up many MW stations on 1557 kHz to jam RTI. So this “DRM test” is actually a new jamming to RTI with DRM technology.

It is said the DRM coding software and modulator was developed by Communication University of China in Beijing. The transmitter is “GZ-G10K”, 10 kW MW DRM transmitter, manufactured by Harbin Broadcasting Equipment Co. Ltd. In addition, some MW transmitters in Yunnan, Liaoning, Jiangsu and other provinces have also carried out DRM test broadcasting, but the specific test information is not announced. Yunnan reportedly uses name “YUNNAN Broadcast”, xHE-AAC code, ID: 9FFF05.

Xiamen (Amoy) Radio and Television Group (XRTG), Fujian province, announced on 23 December 23 as follows:

1. By the order of National Radio and Television Administration (NRTA), **Xiamen Travel Radio** (94.0 MHz / 1008 kHz 10kW) will stop transmission at 1600UT on 30 December 2024.
2. From 1 January 2025, **Xiamen Economic and Traffic Radio** (107.0MHz / 1278 kHz) will be renamed to “**Xiamen Traffic and Travel Radio**”, taking over some programs of **Xiamen Travel Radio**.

From 1 January 2025, XRTG will operate 4 radio networks:

Xiamen General Radio on AM 1107 kHz 10kW

Xiamen Traffic and Tourism Radio on AM 1278 kHz 10kW

Xiamen Music Radio on FM only

Xiamen Minnan Voice Radio on AM 801 kHz 10kW

Xiamen Travel Radio started trial broadcasting in August 2008 only on medium wave. FM frequency was later added. The formal opening of the radio station was 1 January 2011.

“**Voice of Pujiang**” on 1422 kHz 25kW, a radio service for Taiwan operated by Shanghai Radio & Television Station (SMG: Shanghai Media Group), terminated its broadcast on 1 January 2025 without prior notice. The station began transmission in January 1988, in 2000's was using shortwave (3280, 4950, 9705kHz etc.) along with 1422 kHz, received by the listeners around the world. The shortwave transmission ended in May 2013.

By the way “Pujiang” is the abbreviation of “Hungpu River” in Shanghai. On the same day SMG also terminated **Story Radio** (102.7MHz), **5 Star Sports Radio** (94.0 MHz), **Lovejoy Fashion Radio** (98.1 MHz) and 3 TV channels without notice.

Finland

Arctic Radio update February 2025:

The 1kW longwave transmitter is now ready and a matching unit is currently being built. The antenna has been a big problem and due to the winter conditions it's unrealistic to expect any station startup before the summer now.

The 300kW transmitter that was offered was withdrawn and an extremely high price tag was put on the dismantling and engineering oversight by the communications company. The costs were vastly inflated in order to deter the project from acquiring this transmitter. In fact the costs were double that of a TRAM LW transmitter shipped complete! Other high-power transmitters may become available in time as decisions have not yet been made about them. The stations interest in these has been conveyed to the companies.

In all the amount of communication alone spent on this project is immense. The station is still getting emails from well-wishers and pleas from people to succeed so it drives the project on knowing at least some people will be happy to hear the station on air. We would still really need a higher power transmitter so any leads are very welcome no matter how old the transmitter is. MW, LW or SW!

We have been offered a 1kW MW transmitter so this will be used for a project that will be announced in a few months. Interest in Shortwave broadcasting has also been expressed so if we can find a shortwave transmitter or even a good broadband linear amplifier SW can start very easily. <https://arcticradio.net/news> *(Mike Barraclough to MWlist iog 14.2.2025)*



Fiji

The Fijian Broadcasting Corporation (FBC) has launched its 70th birthday celebrations at Viseisei village in Vuda, Lautoka. FBC's journey began on 1 July 1954 with the broadcast of its first programme during the official opening ceremony. Today, the corporation operates 6 radio stations, with two in each of the major local languages: Fijian, Hindustani, and English.

The event marks a significant milestone for the organization, celebrating its 7 decades of broadcasting in Fiji and successful transition to the digital era. Veteran Radio Fiji One announcer Apakuki Waqa emphasised the importance of this anniversary, highlighting the organization's achievements over the years. "FBC has come a long way, and it has produced a number of prominent radio and news presenters in the country," he said. The anniversary celebration will include visits to 70 villages across the country, reflecting FBC's deep connection with local communities. It will also coincide with the 2025 edition of the Pacific Media Partnership Conference (PMPC) to be held in partnership with the Asia-Pacific Broadcasting Union from 11 to 13 February.

The PMPC is an opportunity to harness the wisdom and experience of the ABU's Pacific members while hearing insights from some of the world's best experts.

New Zealand

At the end of January, **RNZ** retired its aging AM radio transmitter site at Waingawa in the Wairarapa, which uses broadcasts **RNZ National** on **1071 AM**. Listeners in the rural Wairarapa area from Lake Ferry to Eketahuna now need to retune to either 101.5 FM or **567 AM** (from Titahi Bay, north of Wellington) to continue listening to RNZ National. David Headland in North Otago advises the **1071** transmitter closed at



at approximately 19:11 UTC on 31 January, 8.11am local time on 1 February. No announcements were heard on **RNZ National** just before the closure. David was hoping there may have been a short message considering it has been on air for around 60 years.

According to the earlier **RNZ** notice of closure on their website forwarded by Tony King, “the Waingawa mast was put up 60 years ago and predates the FM transmitter. At the time, to increase AM frequency in suburban areas, infill sites like Waingawa were put up. Because FM is now servicing the more populated areas of the Wairarapa the Waingawa mast is no longer needed. The mast has reached the end of its useful life and requires either removal or remediation. It is not safe to allow the aging mast to stay up indefinitely. Replacing the mast would be an expensive exercise to allow a frequency to continue that is no longer needed. **RNZ** is publicly funded and we do not consider that this would be a good use of public money.” **RNZ** also advised that, following closure of the Waingawa mast and transmitter, the **1071** frequency will be reassigned to RNZ’s Wainui (Gisborne) site. **RNZ National** currently transmits on **1314 AM** from this site and a move to the lower **1071** frequency will increase its coverage on the East Coast, improving resilience for one of New Zealand’s more remote regions.

NewstalkZB

Theo Donnelly pointed out that the Waingawa mast was also used by **Newstalk ZB** so it was anticipated **846** would also go silent at the end of January, though no prior information appeared on their Facebook page. However David Headland and David Kaio report hearing a loop message on **846** on 30 and 31 January: “NewsTalk ZB in Masterton on the frequency you’re listening to right now, has been switched off. You need to make the switch to 103.9 FM to stay listening to all your favourite hosts on **NewsTalk ZB** Masterton or download the I-Heart radio app and stream us online. Flick over right now to 103.9 FM. Change your preset on your radio and stay with us - NewsTalk ZB Masterton 103.9 FM”. David H confirms the transmitter carrier was dropped at 1908 UTC 31 January.

In Wellington, **711 Sport Nation** was noted absent on 16 or 17 January but back on air 19 January. Sometime in December, the station had begun transmitting on **1233 AM** as well, replacing **The Breeze**. David Kaio has noted different advertising being carried on each frequency.



New Zealand's oldest radio station narrowly avoided shutting down after finding itself without a home. **Radio Dunedin (1305 AM)** has been given until May 2025 to move out of its current premises, in ASB House, which it has occupied for the past 26 years. **Radio Dunedin** president Gordon Paine said the station's executive committee voted unanimously to enter into a partnership with **Radio Aotearoa**, an Auckland-based broadcaster, whom they were working with to keep the station on air. **Radio Aotearoa** will set up a studio and supply equipment in Dunedin, and the two stations will share the same frequency and combine their music libraries. The New Zealand radio industry was "a small place" and those who had heard of Radio Dunedin's plight did not want to let the station go, Mr Paine said. "We're the oldest radio station in New Zealand ... and Radio Aotearoa didn't want to see that go. "I don't blame them. I don't want to see it go either. "It's something the city should be proud of."

Radio Dunedin was established in 1922, making it New Zealand's first and oldest radio station. Mr Paine said, for reasons unknown, MediaWorks had decided to reduce the space it was occupying in the building and the station would have to leave. **Radio Dunedin** has an airtime lease arrangement with MediaWorks and uses some of its studios. The media company first told the radio station of the proposal in March 2024, before telling it around October it would have to be out in December. After negotiations, the move-out date had been pushed to the end of May 2025, with Radio Dunedin having since partnered with **Radio Aotearoa**. **Radio Dunedin** would have had to consider other options had it not been able to secure equipment or a frequency, and would have been "more likely to shut down" without **Radio Aotearoa**, Mr Paine said. "There's nothing we can do to make [MediaWorks] keep us. It's their floor and they've got their reasons, I assume. "We haven't stopped being in business but we're going to be up and running and stronger." (It now appears that **Radio Aotearoa** may be taking over the 95.4 FM frequency from **Radio Dunedin**, leaving them with just **1305** and an LPFM outlet. BC 29/1)



RNZ will move into TVNZ's headquarters in central Auckland this year, in a deal that could and should pave the way for more collaboration between the two public broadcasters. The move – which will see some 150 RNZ staff shift into TVNZ's Victoria St building – was announced to staff this morning. It will see the 2 newsrooms come together under one roof although, at this stage, the operations will remain strictly separate. The move will spark speculation about how closely the two companies can and should be working together, following the failed merger plans under the previous Labour Government. While the news operations will stay separate for now, the co-location should give executives an opportunity to see where and how they can collaborate on breaking news stories and deeper investigations. There might also be an opportunity for, eventually, combined backroom operations. (NZ Herald Media Insider 18/12) (NZ DX-times, February 2025)

Poland



Polish public broadcaster Polskie Radio is commemorating its centennial, marking a century since its inaugural transmission in Poland.

The first trial broadcast occurred on Feb. 1, 1925 from a Warsaw station operated by the now-defunct Polish Radio Technical Society (PTR). The initial words, delivered by PTR Director Roman Rudniewski, were: “This is the trial radio broadcasting station of the Polish Radio Technical Society on the **385-metre wave band.**”

This technical experiment led to the official establishment of **Polish Radio** on Aug. 18, 1925. Regular programming commenced on Apr. 18, 1926, laying the foundation for a rich legacy in Polish media.

Polskie Radio is hosting a series of events throughout 2025 to commemorate its centennial. These include special broadcasts, historical retrospectives and public exhibitions highlighting the evolution of radio in Poland. Argentina

A recent survey of the AMBA (Buenos Aires Metropolitan Area) AMFM dial, carried out in early February 2025, reveals that there are many radio stations that are not active, most likely affected by power outages. The high temperatures affecting the area of the City of Buenos Aires and its surroundings, implies an increase in the demand for electricity to combat the heat wave, and in particular, the simultaneity in the use of air conditioners, causes overloads of the electrical system, which leads to interruptions in the supply by the companies providing the service, which is sometimes also affected by inclement weather (severe storms and lightning) that cause failures or breakdowns in the medium and/or high voltage network. In recent days, when the ambient temperature reached 38° Celsius, there have been many power outages in large areas of the capital and the Buenos Aires suburbs, and many Medium Wave and FM radio stations have suffered. According to a check of the AM dial, several radio stations are off the air.

DX-Memories from 1983: 1000/1567 SSR Southside Radio Bray Co Wicklow/Dun Laoghaire, Co Dublin

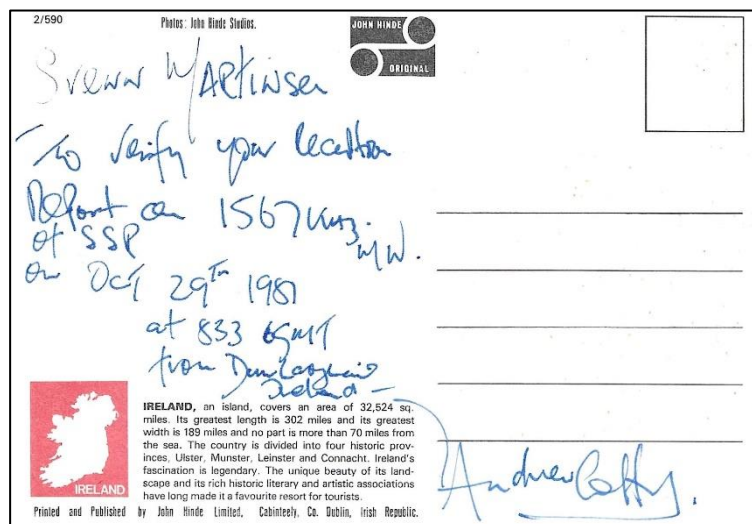

Frekvensområdet 997-1002 kHz huset en god del irsk radioaktivitet i området sør for Dublin rundt starten av 1980-tallet. Alt i 1979 kunne JA, Jan Alvestad melde om logging av Southside Radio på 997 kHz, da lokalisert med studio i en campingvogn i nærheten av Bray i Co Wicklow. RM, Rolf Mong hørte stasjonen 21.september 1981 fra fergehavnen Dún Laoghaire (*anglifisert stavemåte Dunleary*) i Co.Dublin på 1000 kHz. Høsten 1981 gjorde en annen dx-kollega KAO, Kjell Arne Olsen meg oppmerksom på at han hadde hørt en ny irsk kommersiell sender på 1567 kHz. Og ganske riktig, om morgenen 29.oktober kl.0840 GMT dukket 1567 også opp i min Redifon 50M med bra signaler på denne frekvensen, med SSR, Southside Radio¹ IDer, reklame for motorsykler og en restaurant i Dún Laoghaire. Og dagen etter ble stasjonen hørt kl 1015 GMT også på 1000 kHz men med mye lavere modulasjon enn 1567. Også neste høst oppfanget vi aktivitet i dette området, men da var trolig stasjonen borte og senderanlegget overtatt av andre. Jeg hørte for eksempel Radio South(side?) på 999 24.september 1982 med QRM fra IBAs testsenderinger for Red Rose Radio fra Preston, mens HAH Harry Høgberg fanget South City Radio på samme frekvens 20.november samme år. QTH ble da oppgitt som Foxrock. Et senderanlegg i Shankill som ble eid av Joe Jackson ble sagt å være involvert i flere av sendingene rundt 1000 kHz. Joe var ellers kjent for å ha vært vert for flere stasjoner på 1314, Sonic Independent Radio², East Coast 228, Island radio, så vel som vikar for Radio Nova(828 kHz) etter raidet på denne 18.mai 1983.

Nesten to år etter, torsdag 23.juni 1983 besøkte jeg en av storstasjonene i Dublin, Sunshine Radio, først tok jeg bussen ut til kysten og møtte staben i stasjonens studioer, som lå like ved den høye sendermasten ved senderanlegget bak Sands Hotel i badebyen Portmarnock. Senere besøkte jeg ledelsen i kontorene i Lower Baggot Street.

Jeg forteller om besøket på Sunshine i en egen artikkel, men aktuelt her er at jeg fikk en prat med Sunshines daværende dj Andy Rua(ne)alias Paul Nicholas, og da fortalte jeg litt om de mange stasjonene jeg hadde hørt fra Éire.

Men hørte du vår stasjon SSR Southside? Javisst gjorde jeg det! Og så spilte jeg opptak fra 1567 for Andy på kassettpilleren. Og da deres jingle ble spilt sang han med!

Southside Radio var en av de tidlige irske mellombølgepiratene på slutten av 1970- og begynnelsen av 1980-tallet, og sendte fra forskjellige steder i Nord-Wicklow og sør i Dublin. Den begynte å sende noen timer daglig i desember 1978 til nordre delen av Co. Wicklow før dekningen ble utvidet. Et ratecard, coverage map og program schedule fra desember 1979 gav inntrykk av et ambisiøst og seriøst prosjekt. Stasjonen hadde dyktige kringkastingspersonligheter som Bryan Dobson, Cathy Cregan, Sybil Fennell, Hugh Browne (RIP), Paul Nicholas (Andy Ruane), Johnny Lewis og Tommy Greene. Alle endte senere opp på større stasjoner, og noen på riksdekkende radio.

Southside hevdet å være *the major radio station on the southside of Dublin* og *the Gentle Giant* og sa at den hadde *community emphasis* i programmene sine. Våren 1980 ble stasjonen rammet av lynnedslag og innbrudd og dette gjorde skade på stasjonen. I juni samme år flyttet Southside til kjelleren i Hotel Victor i Rochestown Avenue i Dún Laoghaire med sendinger på 1567 og økte sendetiden enda mer. Mye kan tyde på at 1567 kom i drift rundt 1.mai 1981 med en sterkere sender med 2,5 kW's effekt, men året etter stengte stasjonen for godt. En RCA E.T. 500w tx ble solgt til RCR Royal County Radio på 846 kHz. Et opptak fra 999 kHz 19. april 1981 1133-1305 ligger på den første lenken under og ble relesendt bl.a. på kortbølgestasjonen Westside Radio International og hørt langt utenfor Irland. Her er mange annonser for lokale bedrifter på sørsiden av Dublin, også her med stemmen til Tony Allan (RIP), som også er med å IDE stasjonen.

I Skandinavia hørte vi altså stasjonen også på mellombølgen!

History of Radio in Costa Rica (62): La Voz del Hogar

TILB – La Voz del Hogar was inaugurated in May 1940 on 1045 kHz. The station was formerly Radio La Perla which survived for only four months. They changed frequency to 1100 kHz and it seemed that they kept on the air only in 1940. Afterwards, they became TIMACHO, of Macho Chávez in June 1942. As explained in earlier series that TIMACHO adopted traditional name "La Voz del Hogar" in 1944.

Säga vad man vill men nog är det något visst med radiostationsvimplar. Det är som vi än i dag kunde återuppleva den glädje vi erfor när vi en gång sprättade upp ett brev från en radiostation och i det hittade en vimpel, tillsammans med QSL-et. Hur många av oss har inte dekorerat radiohörnan med vimplar? Sedan har de legat undanstoppade någonstans i många år. Men varför inte pröva att ta fram dina gamla pärmar med QSL och vimplar någon kväll? Slå dig ned i en bekväm fåtölj och börja bläddra. Jag lovar att det blir en behaglig tidsresa. Tillbaka till radions gyllene år. När radion inte bara stod på i bakgrunden som en ljudtapet utan faktiskt var en stor del av vardagen. En källa till underhållning, information och tröst. Långt innan Spotify och andra nedladdningstjänster var påtänkta.

I anslutning till detta kommer jag att tänka på en intervju jag gjorde med "radioshejken" Charlie Norman för länge sedan. Han fick detta smeknamn när han gjorde program för Dux Radio, en svensk kommersiell station som sände på kortvåg från Tanger under 1950-talet. Mot slutet av intervjun kom vi att tala om hur radion utvecklats, i den mån man kan tala om utveckling, och hur radio av i dag låter. Ja, som den lät då. Jag kan inte påstå att det har blivit bättre med åren.... Men Charlie sa något som jag tycker var både vackert och tänkvärt. Han sa att det i radiohuset borde finnas en stor tavla på väggen. En tavla som visar en gammal dam som sitter ensam framför sin radio. Denna dam, menade Charlie, kanske inte har något annat sällskap än radion. Radion kan vara hennes enda tröst i livet. Se denna dam framför dig när du gör dina program. Något som han tyckte alla programledare borde tänka på. Jag kan bara instämma.

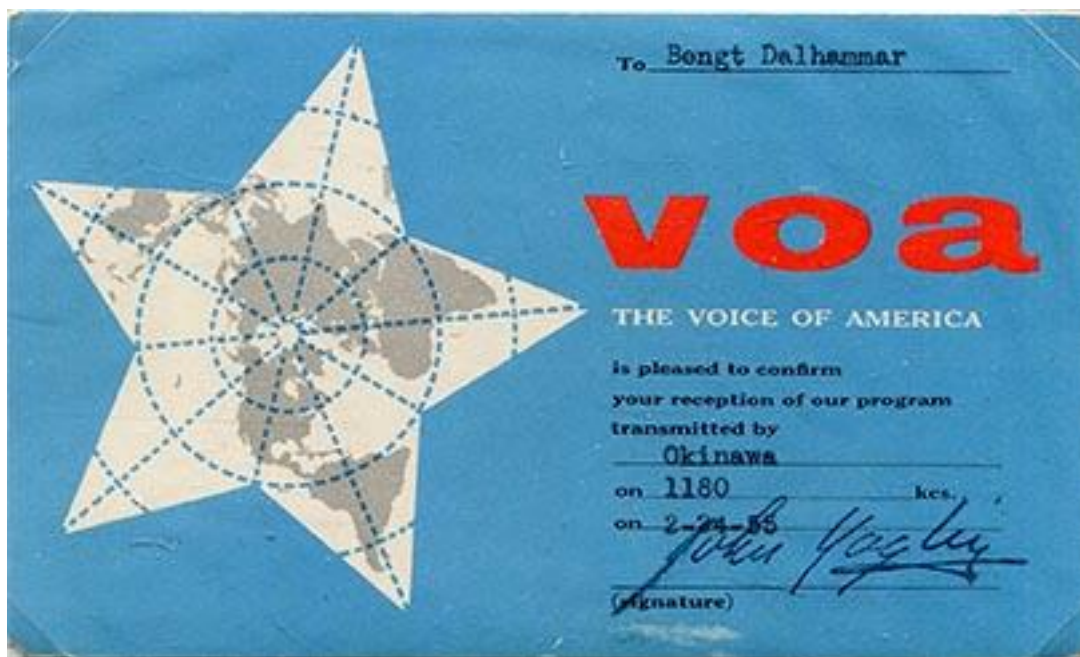

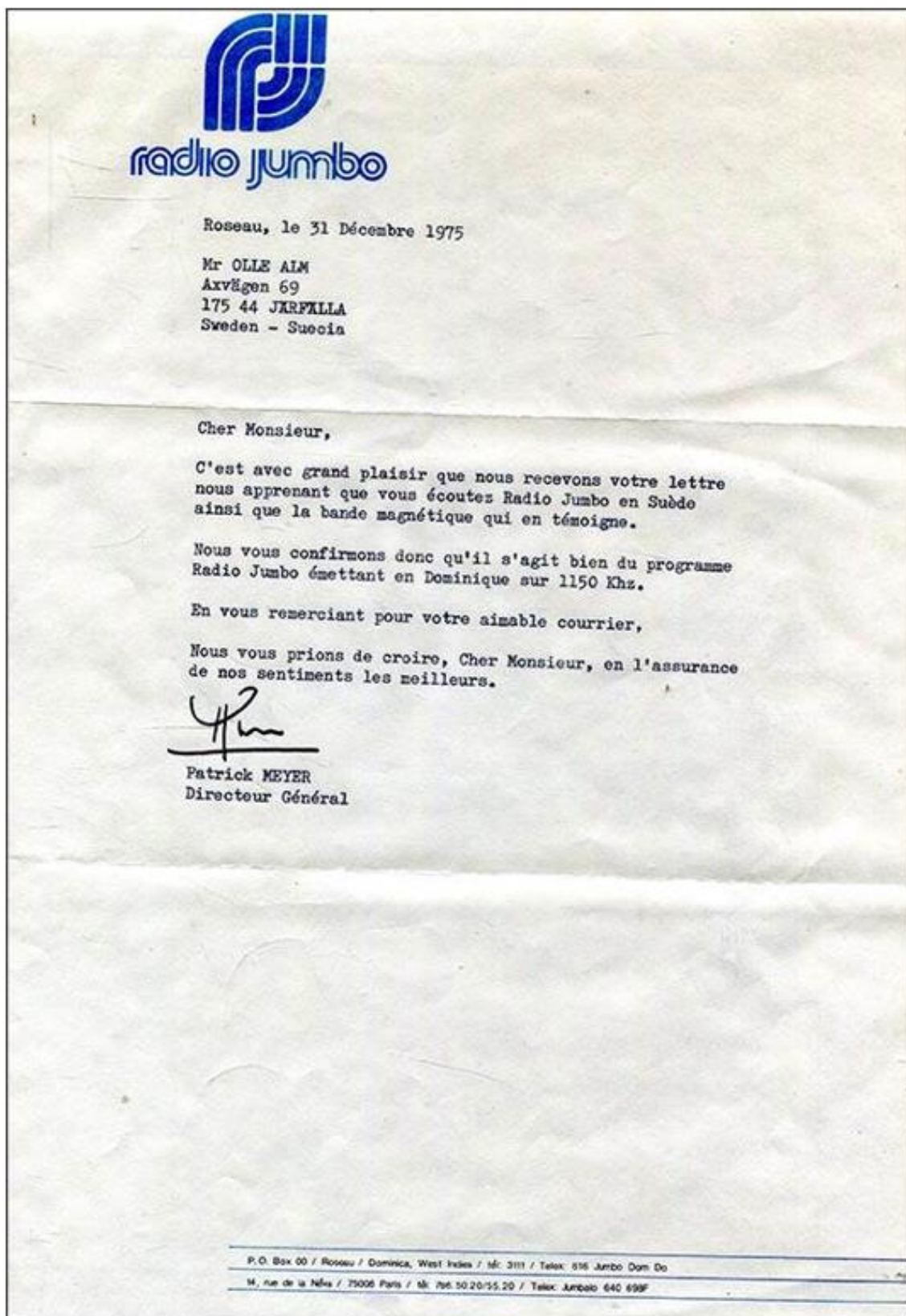

Många äldre ARC-are minns säkert denna natt när åtskilliga spanska mellanvågsstationer sände insamlingsprogram för de drabbade på övertid. Den officiella siffran för antalet omkomna var 617 men det uppskattas att så många som 1 000 personer kan ha omkommit. 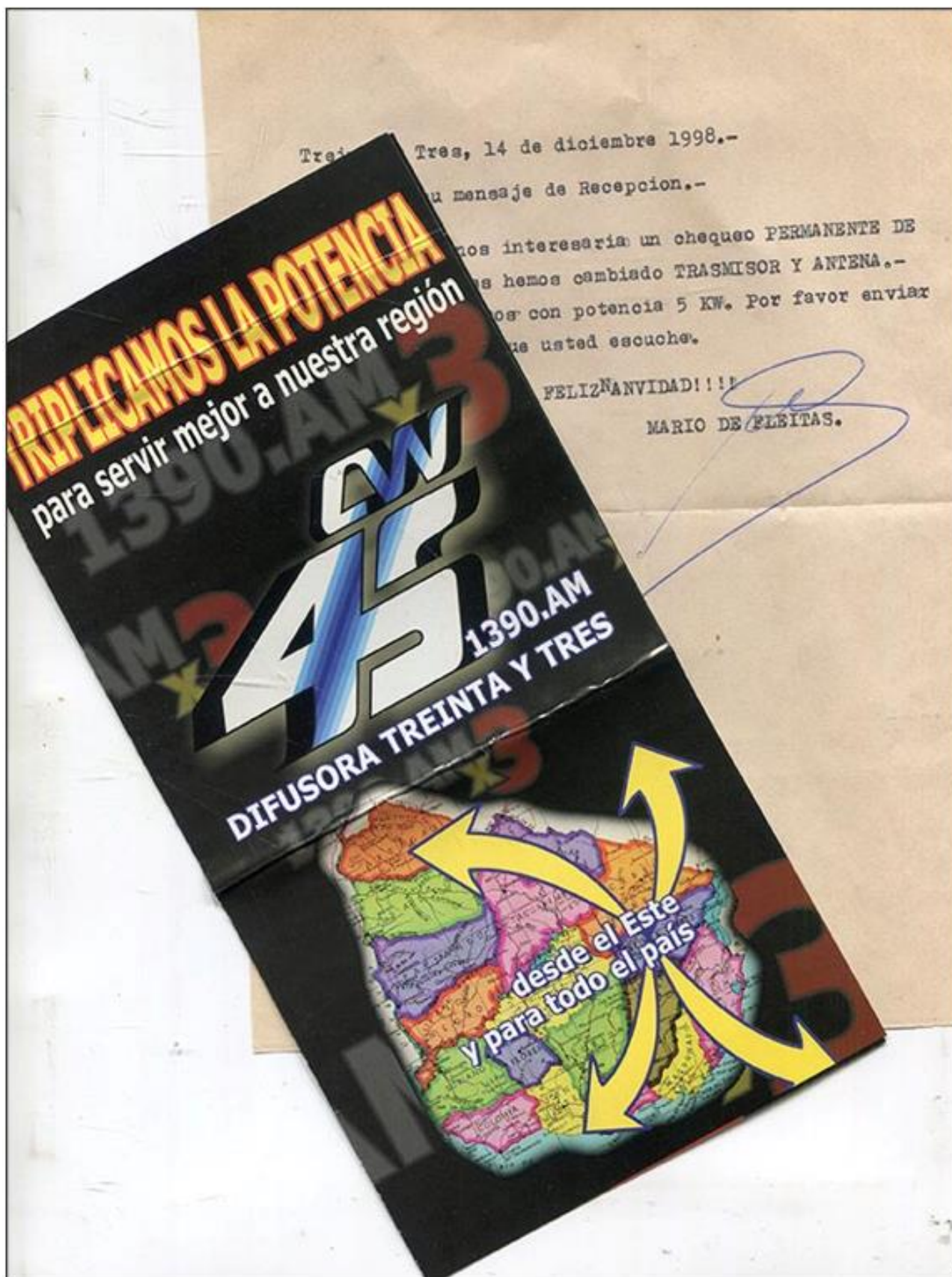
Jag tror nog de flesta äldre DX-are (finns det några yngre?) känner igen detta klassiska kort från VOA. Bengt Dalhammar BD fick detta för en rapport på stationen i Okinawa år 1955. Den kraftiga mellanvågssändaren på 1180 kHz var lätthörd och störde ibland Hörbysändaren på 1178. Ryukyuöarna var ett eget radioland. Dessa öar ockuperades av USA mot slutet av andra världskriget och anfallet på Japan utgick från öarna. Ryukyuöarna återlämnades till Japan 1972.



Här ett inte alltför vanligt radioland: Dominica. Brevet kommer från Olle Alms samling och som synes var stationen franskspråkig. Radioamatören Ove Sjöström SM7XBI, sändartekniker på Radio Nord och Radio Caroline, brukade tillbringa vintrarna på Dominica. Han berättade att han där ofta fick i uppdrag av borgmästaren på ön (eller "chiefen" som han kallades) att fixa diverse tekniska göromål när han kom till Dominica och varje gång hade "chiefen" en lång lista på saker som behövde åtgärdas. Ove tyckte jag skulle komma över och hälsa på vid tillfälle men tyvärr blev det aldrig så.



Vi avslutar med Jan Edhs svar från Difusora Treinta y Tres på 1390 kHz, en gång en mycket vanlig Uruguaystation. Man skickade med en broschyr och coverage map.

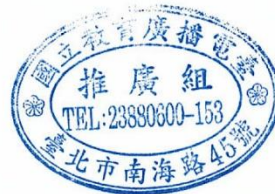

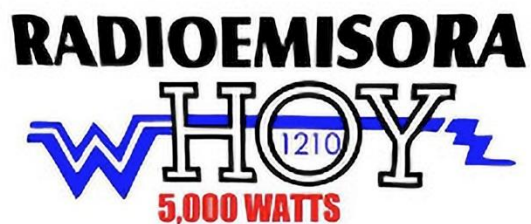
