Australia

1287 kHz 2TM Tamworth moving To 95.5 MHz.

Credit to Paul Mech for emailing details re a planned **1287 kHz** (2 kW) AM to 95.5 MHz (20 kW) FM move. During summertime tropospheric enhancement, 95.5 MHz 2TM should be heard many days in Sydney. A horizontal roof-top rotatable 8-element FM Yagi and TEF6686 tuner is used. Time to start recording **1287** 2TM for remembrance. Once MW switches off, they don't come back.

There are some overseas stations on **1287 kHz** that will sometime later this year be receivable for the first time.

As expected, and confirmed by DXer Paul Mech, **2TM Tamworth 1287 AM** closed mediumwave operation on 16 June. **1287** is now a clear channel in Australia, with **NewsTalk ZB** Westport NZ now audible evenings and early mornings.

Via Todd Emslie ICDX-AM: **3NE Wangaratta 1566** will begin its conversion to FM, with rebranding as **Star FM** on 92.1 MHz. As per ACMA rules, when the FM is fully functional ACMA will only allow AM to be used for a further 28 days, so expect **1566** to be switched off around 28 July.

China

According to the announcement on May 20, 2025 by **Shenzhen Radio TV Movie Group** which controls Shenzhen PBS, they will stop 2 TV channels and MW **1287 kHz** in the near future. No specific date was mentioned. **Shenzhen PBS** is currently using 2 MW frequencies – **900 kHz** (50 kW) for **News Radio** (24H //FM89.8MHz) and **1287 kHz** (25 kW) for **Life Radio** (2225-1800UT //FM94.2MHz).

Shenzhen is the large industrial city in Guangdong province in China, located north of Hong Kong.

1287 kHz was firstly used on May 10, 1999 for the **3rd broadcasting service "Traffic Radio"**, and has been used for **"Life Radio"** after June 18, 2007.

According to reports from some listeners in China, a mediumwave DRM test broadcast was conducted in **Zhengzhou, Hunan Province** on **1377 kHz** from 1300-1339UTC on June 11, 2025. Until now mediumwave "DRM test transmission" have been conducted on only **1557 kHz** from the transmitting stations in certain regions such as **Guangdong, Jiangsu, Yunnan**, and **Liaoning** Provinces. All of these were aimed to jam **Radio Taiwan International** on **1557 kHz** from Koufu transmitter site with 300 kW. Then this maybe the first mediumwave DRM experimental broadcasting in China for its original purpose. The **1377** transmission seems to be from **NRTA No.554 transmitter site at Xingyang, Zhengzhou**.

Typically it broadcasts CNR 1st program "Voice of China" with power of 600 kW.

Greece

ERT Chania **1512 kHz** back on the air.

A few hours before the meeting of the Municipal Council of Chania, today, Wednesday (28/5), with the first issue being the dismantling of the ERT antenna in lower Souda and the revocation of the concession of land from the former Community of Souda to the then EIR, for the construction of a radio transmitter, ERT announced that it had upgraded its Medium Wave equipment! Thus, as of yesterday, the Medium Wave transmitter on frequency 1512, as well as the antenna, is back in operation. With the announcement, **ERT** "informs the public about the completion of the equipment upgrade at the Medium Wave Broadcasting Center in Souda, Chania."

"This upgrade is part of the strategic plan to modernize **ERT**'s radio facilities, with the aim of upgrading broadcast quality and strengthening radio signal coverage throughout the territory.

The **Souda Chania Broadcasting Center** broadcasts in the Medium Wave (AM) band, at the frequency **1512 kHz** and covers the wider area of Crete as well as the **Cyclades islands**, enhancing radio access in areas with limited FM coverage. With this specific intervention, reliable and high-quality signal transmission is ensured and the most complete coverage of southeastern island Greece is achieved."

By unanimous decision of the **ERT Board of Directors**, AM transmitters are being restored in 9 locations across the country. The Souda station in **Chania** is operating again on **1512 kHz**. The Board approved the "mapping" of national coverage on MW throughout the country, including the reopening in Souda, Chania. As Yannis Lyviakis revealed in the "Chaniotika Nea" website, photos and details for the upgrade of the **1512 kHz** transmitter have been posted since May 27. At a time when the resilience of the information system is considered particularly important, the ERT Board of Directors decided to reopen and upgrade AM stations throughout Greece - from Chania to Komotini - for use in cases of emergency national needs. According to the decision posted on "Diavgeia," ERT adopts a strategic plan for national AM radio coverage.

The map above includes the following broadcasting centres: **Chania (Souda), Rhodes, Megara, Malgara, Zakynthos, Boyiati, Corfu, Tripoli, and Komotini**. At the same time, the completion of all required maintenance, operation, and upgrade actions of the antennas was approved in order to ensure their full operational readiness.

At the same time, the Board decided to repeal the previous decision and any other decisions that regulated the use of AM centres differently, unifying the operating framework based on the new map. Also, the **Panhellenic Association of ERT Engineers and Technicians (PASYMITE)** issued a press release on 29 May 29, expressing satisfaction with this decision, as it vindicates their effort to upgrade radio broadcasts on MW. In times of crisis, MW and SW broadcasts remain critical in cases of internet outages or serious natural disasters, as they ensure analog transmission over long distances, even in areas with problematic FM coverage.

846 kHz Newstalk ZB Masterton has closed its AM frequency and now operates on FM.

1449 kHz RNZ National Palmerston North has closed its AM frequency and now operates on FM. (This was due to switch off 12/5/25).

Just of interest, Sanctuary NZL **stations** also identify occasionally as Rhema Media, which can be a bit confusing at times.

I rechecked **1449 kHz** via an NZL SDR, which was receiving **RNZ Palmerston North** previously, early this morning, and the frequency was clear of signals, which indicates the station must have since been switched off. I was able to hear and record **1449 kHz** RNZ from two separate online SDRs before it closed, with one of the SDRs being based in **Palmerston North** providing local reception. Unfortunately, No loop tape has been heard on **1449 kHz** at all. Here in Melbourne, when recently checking **1449 kHz**, there was short reception heard of **6TAB Mandurah WA**, though nothing else.

Palmerston North AM stations **NewsTalkZB** on **927** and **Gold Sport 1089** ceased transmission on Monday 5 May, around 10.43am, that is 2243 UTC on 4 May. *(David Headland)*

The remaining broadcaster on the **Kairanga** mast – **RNZ National** on **1449** closed down on 12 May at 10.06am local time. *(Bryan Clark).*

Palmerston North now has just 3 AM stations left on air – **828 Sport Nation**, **999 Manawatu Peoples Radio** and **1548** a relay of LPFM station **2XSFM 106.7** which is a tribute to local commercial station **2XS** that operated in the 80s and 90s. *(Adam Claydon & David Kaio)*

A NZ group, Engineers for Social Responsibility Inc. (esr.org.nz) has written to **Mark Mitchell**, Minister responsible for Emergency Management and Recovery regarding the “closure of the AM broadcast radio network, initiated by its owner RNZ. The closure of **RNZ National** on **1116** on 31 March is highlighted and ESR claims this will “compromise the national ability to communicate with isolated communities in the event of a civil disaster such as an earthquake or major weather event.

The **National Emergency Management Agency (NEMA)** claiming in its Briefing to the Incoming Minister in 2023 that “... in 2022 we worked with the Ministry of Culture and Heritage to prevent the decommissioning of three AM radio masts in Northland – this meant that Far North residents still had access to safety information during Cyclone Gabrielle.” This explicit acknowledgement of the emergency value of AM Radio is in conflict with the policy to close AM Radio frequencies. Furthermore, we are told that Local Government emergency plans continue to insert specific local AM frequencies in local community emergency plans as recently as last week. Have Local Governments been consulted over the removal of the AM frequencies?” “Two years ago, during Cyclone Gabrielle, large areas of the East Coast were left without power and communications. Bridges were swept away, and in many cases optical fibres were damaged as a result. Cell sites ran out of battery power. VHF FM transmitters typically have a relatively short, line-of-sight range, and this is compounded by New Zealand's mountainous terrain. What this meant is that for many isolated communities, AM radio transmissions were the only means of getting information.

AM transmissions on medium wave have a unique ability to reach remote places, especially at night, because the signal is refracted back from the ionosphere. Most households have a simple AM/FM battery radio, and vehicle radios also have AM capability. An alternative to AM could be satellite phone, but currently the use of this technology is not widespread”. “**RNZ** will be seeking to rid itself of the cost of maintaining the AM network, and may have forgotten its role as provider of official communications. We acknowledge this cost, but argue that this should be set against the potential for saving lives in an emergency. Until an alternative technology is available and widespread, we suggest that the AM network should be retained in its entirety. We would be happy to engage with you further on this matter.”

The minister said **RNZ** had had funding increases in recent years, including a \$26m boost in 2023 and \$7.3m in 2020. In a statement, **RNZ** board chair Jim Mather said the organisation was "naturally disappointed" but it "acknowledged the government's fiscal challenges at present as well as the headwinds affecting the wider media sector".

RNZ is retiring its AM transmission mast in **Tihiotonga, Rotorua** on 30 June. At more than 60 years old, the mast has reached the end of its service life and overlapping signals from other **RNZ** AM/FM sites will cover most of the transmission region. The closure will mean AM listeners in rural **Rotorua District** who currently listen to **RNZ National** on **1188** AM will need to retune to either 101.5 FM or **819** AM by 1 July 2025 to avoid any disruption. **RNZ** currently leases the land the masts its on. **RNZ's** lease will come to an end following completion of the mast demolition and decommission of the site.

Other stations using the Tihiotonga mast – **NewsTalkZB** on **747** and **Gold Sport** on **1350** will also close. Both began airing loop messages on 17 June, as monitored by Bryan Clark and David Kaio. The **NewsTalk ZB** message prompts listeners to retune to 94.3 FM, while **Gold Sport's** message advises they will only be available through online streaming or the **I-Heart Radio mobile phone app**. **RNZ Chief Technology Officer** Mark Bullen said retiring the mast is the right move given the investment required to maintain it. "FM performs better than AM, especially in more built-up areas. Maintaining the mast would require significant investment, and because populations in the impacted area can access **RNZ National** via FM signal and other overlapping AM frequencies, it makes sense to retire the mast at Tihiotonga." **Tihiotonga** is the fourth and final AM mast that **RNZ** will retire around the country in 2025, with masts in **Waingawa** (Wairarapa), **Stoke** (Nelson-Tasman) and **Kairanga** (Manawātū Whanganui) already retired this year. All of these sites are covered by alternative FM and AM coverage from **RNZ's** other transmission locations, and all have reached a point where they can no longer continue to operate without significant investment. While use of AM radio has declined since the introduction of FM, it still has an important role to play, achieving further reach and providing wider coverage than FM, this is especially important for those living away from the main city centres or in remote areas of rugged terrain.

Under **RNZ's** AM Management Plan, 15 resilient AM sites will remain operational, providing nationwide coverage to 97% of New Zealand's population till at least 2032. Masts which achieve the best New Zealand DX Times radiodx.com © 2025 NZRDXL 10 of 35 July 2025 10 of 35 population coverage have been prioritised and will be either replaced or repaired. The **RNZ** AM Management Plan also specifically recognises **RNZ's** role as a lifeline utility and the need to support New Zealanders during and after significant civil defence events and therefore **RNZ** is maintaining sites with a smaller population coverage that are unable to receive other ways of accessing **RNZ** because of their remoteness.

At the end of June, **Sport Nation's 1224** AM frequency that serves **Invercargill** and the wider **Southland** region will switch to being a **digital only** station. In a website update on 25 June, **SENZ** state "we will still be delivering all of our great content day and night through our online streams on the **Sport Nation** website and app - available on the App Store and Google Play. **Sport Nation** is believed to be the only broadcaster on the **Kennington mast** on the eastern outskirts of **Invercargill**."

There's been another twist in the saga of what is happening in the **Auckland** AM radio scene. We've previously covered **RNZ's** intentions to set up a new AM transmitting site at **Awhitu** on the south side of **Auckland's Manukau Harbour**, to allow eventual retirement of one of the 2 antenna masts at **Henderson**. The following major story broke in the 9 June 'NZ Herald' Media Insider' column, headlined "AM transmissions of up to 7 **Auckland** radio stations – including sport and Pacific broadcasts – threatened under **RNZ** plans to replace transmission masts". Two massive transmission masts - features of the west Auckland skyline - are now at the centre of a brewing battle that may determine the future of several radio stations. The AM services of up to 7 **Auckland** radio stations, including 2 catering to sports fans and several serving ethnic communities, are under threat, with **RNZ** proposing to replace two large transmission masts with just one. The radio industry is gearing up for a potential legal battle with **RNZ**, partly based on the belief it may be breaching its charter and public broadcasting responsibilities. Commercial operators say **RNZ** has been earning profits from them for many years to sustain the masts and account for future plans. However, **RNZ** says it is "not established as an infrastructure provider to other broadcasters" and that it has to recover its costs.

At the heart of the looming showdown are two prominent AM transmission masts on either side of **Auckland's Northwestern Motorway**, at the **Lincoln Rd** interchange in **Henderson**. The red and white masts are well-known landmarks; 15 radio stations rely on them for their AM services. There are 8 on the "northern" mast (**Radio Waatea, Humm, BBC World Service, Chinese Voices, Newstalk ZB, Rhema, Radio Tarana** and **Radio Samoa**) and 7 on the "southern" mast (**531PI, RNZ National, Parliament, APNA, Ake 1179, Gold Sport AM** and **Sport Nation**). According to **RNZ**, both masts need replacing. **The southern mast on Lincoln Road** is 153 metres high and 70 years old. **The northern Selwood Road mast** is 122 metres high and 91 years old. "The masts have a design life of 50 years, which **RNZ** has managed to extend until now," says **RNZ** chief technology officer Mark Bullen. **RNZ** says it needs to remove both masts and – while it insists no final decision has been made – it has proposed replacing just the northern mast. Sources say **RNZ** has been prepared to build a new southern mast but only if every existing tenant agrees to pay increased fees. The radio industry is baulking at the proposed fees and wants to see **RNZ's** costings. Under the one-mast scenario, **RNZ** would move **RNZ National** and **Parliament** from the southern mast to a new northern mast at the expense of at least one and possibly 2 of the existing northern mast stations. Up to 5 other stations on the southern mast would also lose New Zealand DX Times radiodx.com © 2025 NZRDXL 11 of 35 July 2025 11 of 35 their AM transmissions, including **Sport Nation** – the Entain channel that has live cricket rights – and NZME's **Gold Sport AM**, which has live rugby rights. Other AM stations on the southern mast include those that cater to specific communities in **Auckland**, including **531PI** for the Pasifika community, **APNA** for the Indian, Fijian, Bangladeshi, Pakistani and Punjabi communities, and **Ake 1179**, the official station of Ngāti Whātua.

Many of the 15 stations have a digital presence, but for some of them, AM is the main or only means of transmission. The radio industry says New Zealand still has strong AM audiences because of the country's geography, topography and high percentage of second-hand imported cars from Japan with radios that usually go up to only 90FM. Media Insider understands some in the commercial radio industry are infuriated by **RNZ's** position, believing its proposed costs are inflated. They are also angry about what they label sky-high, ongoing fees **RNZ** is proposing for those who are lucky enough to have a spot on the new northern mast. The **Radio Broadcasters Association** has engaged a lawyer and fired a shot across **RNZ's** bow, threatening legal action. It is understood that the lawyer has told **RNZ** that withdrawing transmission services would come at a high cost for the public and broadcasters. And that from a charter, public law and a plurality perspective, this included broadcasting to the Pacific Island, Samoan, Chinese, Indian, Māori, and Christian communities". **RNZ's** Mark Bullen said in the statement that "no legal proceedings have commenced. While **RNZ** cannot speak to the specific intentions of the co-siters, we are in ongoing conversation with them". Bullen said **RNZ** had engaged with the industry about AM transmission at its Henderson sites "for many years". "Based on structural engineers' reports, we have decided to decommission both towers by June 2026 to ensure the health and safety of both sites," Bullen said. "The building of a new mast on the northern site would be sufficient to meet **RNZ's** transmission needs. **RNZ** is now talking to broadcasters ... about the financial viability of building a new mast on the southern site.

Whether there are sufficient clients and ongoing revenue to make it financially prudent for **RNZ** to invest in the southern site [is] part of **RNZ**'s consideration." He said if **RNZ** decided "not to fund the mast, **RNZ** is open to ideas from co-sitters that would provide other viable, funded plans. **RNZ** has also had discussions with Government officials on technical options around additional FM services, but were advised this is not viable." Bullen said replacing both masts would cost in the range of \$7 million, with the southern mast estimated to be close to \$3m. "In summary, no final decision has been taken on the southern site and we are awaiting further feedback from co-sitters who we have been engaging with regularly."

LLE-2 our first MW transmitter(1 kW) came back on air with reduced power on Sunday July 6th after a long break since May 31st except from a small daytime test mid-June. This was due to a burned-out spool in the ATU(Antenna Tuning Unit). Repairs seemed to be complicated, but our technical experts took the challenge. Hopefully the station will stay in top form as we plan a new format on this channel from September 1st.

1575 kHz

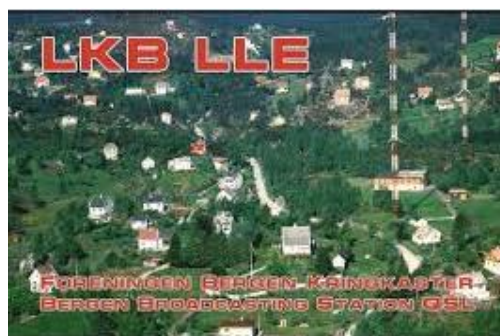
LLE-4 our second MW transmitter ex **1611 kHz** (until the end of 2023) has been allocated this channel after our application to NKOM with three alternatives in 2024.

We intend to commence broadcasting early autumn 2025, at the outset//5895 kHz.

The application and coordination process has indeed taken a long time but was done brilliantly by NKOM. The license is for 6 years and presently allows 1 kW ERP.

Initially, our 2 kW tx will be used, most likely with @750 watts, and the former 1611 installation will be utilized with some modifications.

When on 1611 the «inverted V» antenna had a modest daytime performance but a good skywave and was heard in Canada. It seems to have best coverage NW/SE.



We are very grateful to the Norwegian Media Authorities who have shown us this confidence after now 13 years of broadcasting from the old **LKB LLE** site. We are now the only remaining Norwegian AM stations on the mainland, but of course **LKL Svalbard Kringkaster** on 1485 carrying **NRK P1** is still broadcasting and has been improved.

Under the Copenhagen Plan in November 1978 Norway had 2 transmitters(**LKF Fredrikstad** 10 kW and **LKN3 "Nordkapp"** (Honningsvåg) 2 kW) on 1578 kHz and shared the channel with Italy 50 kW (+19 low power stations) and Portugal 10 kW.

On the side 1575 Sharjah 50 kW and 1580 VOA Ban Pachi 1000 kW were often heard. So the channel will be less crowded now!

We hope we will be heard far away! Correct reception reports to styret2025 at bergenkringkaster.no will be answered by eQSL.

The high-power transmitter located in **Chugalpura** was disconnected by **Peshawar Electric Supply Company (PESCO)**, effectively halting AM (1260 kHz) and shortwave radio broadcasts in the region. For the past two weeks I've been using the **Manila and Negros Occidental remote webSDRs** to survey Filipino broadcasters on the mediumwave band in both locations. In Manila it was noted that **DWDD Armed Forces Radio (aka Katropa Radyo)** is no longer heard on mediumwave, being untraced on its former frequency of **1134** kHz or elsewhere on the band. **DZUP University Radio** was also absent on **1602** kHz, but this may possibly due to their low power (1 kW) and/or them possibly broadcasting only on specific school days. Outreach GoldApril 2025

A new LPAM Station Outreach Gold is due to launch in the near future on 1557 kHz from Chandlers Ford near Eastleigh Hampshire. Content will be from the 1950s to 1980s.

This will be the first new LPAM for a number of years, at present there are only 21 LPAM in operation, with most run by BFBS. (Note I have had some recent reports of some LPAMS being off air, I would welcome any updates.)

Radio 4 longwave16 June 2025

The keep longwave web site, has a update on the fact that 5000 signatures petition has been handed into BBC Broadcasting house. The planned closure on June 30th does now look like being postponed, despite a number of programmes on radio and tv, warning Radio Tele switch customers of the impending deadline. RTS 198 kHz longwave19 June 2025

The 198 kHz transmitters are used to broadcast the data signals used for the Radio Teleswitching Service in the UK. This service was supposed to cease on 30th June 2025 and the ofgem website still says this. This website <https://www.energynetworks.org/industry/engineering-and-technical-programmes/radio-teleswitch> run by the organisation responsible for RTS says service has been extended to June 2025. Both websites are out of date and wrong. On 19th June, the Department for Energy Security and Net Zero announced that "a widespread switch-off [...] will not happen on 30 June", the service being phased out in stages instead. <https://www.gov.uk/government/news/government-steps-in-to-protect-consumers-with-old-energy-meters> As of 30 May 2025 314935 homes in the UK were still dependent on the RTS service on 198 kHz. The first stage of the phase-out will target specific, localised areas, affecting a maximum of 600 households over a 3 week period – with the government and industry carefully monitoring suppliers' response times and their effectiveness in supporting vulnerable customers.

Radio Mi Amigo6 June 2025

The latest Ofcom Broadcast update lists a new low power AM service, Radio Mi Amigo based in Harwich on the LV18 lightship. The station was given a 5 year LPAM restricted service licence on June 1st. Wireless of the Week (Chris Brisland) said that they are now carrying out tests on 1575 The lightship suffered fire damage caused by a arson attack in February 2024, and is slowly making progress on getting various parts of the ship renovated. Power believed to be 1 watt. The Radio Mi Amigo service is currently on line. <https://lv18radio.uk>

Ofcom updates compliance check list16 June 2025

Ofcom have updated the Broadcast Radio compliance lists. Key points in particular with Community Radio include clearer expectations around language use and studio location. Ofcom says that when specific languages are referenced in a station's character of service, some programming in those languages should be broadcast each week. And confirming that studios should be inside the coverage area.

Radiomuséet i luften igen

av Ronny Forslund RFK

Vi minns väl litet till mans Fiskhamnsrapporten, som brukade sändas fem i tolv över mellanvågssändaren i Järnbrott, Göteborg? SR Göteborg verifierade också snabbt med ett eget QSL-kort. Denna epok i Göteborgs radiohistoria upphörde i mars 1984 när mellanvågssändaren stängdes. Under åren har Radiomuséet i Göteborg använt frekvensen 981 kHz för sporadiska sändningar. Jag minns fortfarande när JE och jag satt i torpet i Fredriksfors och kämpade för att få in stationens första sändning. Men mest var det Algeriet och Irland som gick och från Göteborg hördes inte ett pip. Man sände då med en 200W rörbestyckad gammal P2-sändare som knappt ens hördes i Göteborg.

Under helgen 24-25 maj 2025 var det dags igen. Då hölls ett stort bilevent med mängder av gamla fina entusiastbilar på Lindholmen, i muséets närhet. Inför detta event föddes tanken att sända på mellanvåg till alla bilentusiaster som ju har mellanvågsmottagare i sina bilar. Ett tillfälligt tillstånd erhöles av PTS och Mediemyndigheten och man gjorde även ett avtal med STIM. Enligt detta avtal fick man sända i 48 timmar totalt vilket man också gjorde.

Innan sändningarna kom igång togs kontakt med Tore Andersson SMØDCB, som hjälpt oss i Radio Nord Revival att sända våra program under åren. Han lånade ut ett slutsteg som vi använde för sändningar på 1512 kHz från Vaxholms Kastell. Men det skulle visa sig att slutsteget inte fungerade på en så låg frekvens som 981 kHz och muséets radioteam fick köra utan slutsteg. En Tornado 10W sändare från 6V6 i England användes och denna gav bra mottagning på Hisingen och i centrala Göteborg. Dessutom hördes man, låt vara svagt, på platser som Härryda och Kungsbacka.

Ett praktiskt problem var antennen. En kvartsvågsantenn för våglängden 306 meter gick inte att åstadkomma på muséets fastighet utan man fick dra antennwiren över till ett grannhus. Något som fick göras kvällstid då antennen delvis gick över en parkeringsplats. Men man fick ett bra jordplan trots att de gamla järnvägsspåren nu är borta. Den 75 meter långa ändmatade antennen jordades i museibygnadens radiatorsystem och det blev en utmärkt motvikt.

Förra gången vi försökte höra Radiomuséets sändningar i Fredriksfors fanns inga Kiwimottagare. Nu lyckades jag höra sändningarna över en sådan mottagare belägen på Grötö i Göteborgs skärgård, dock med en mottagning knappt över brusnivån. Jag spelade också in MV-bandet på Perséusen i Fredriksfortorpet för att kolla om sändningarna från Göteborg lyckats ta sig ända dit. Men det var mest Český Impuls som hördes.... När jag lyssnade över Grötökiwin hördes svensk schlagermusik med bland andra Lill-Babs och Anna-Lena Löfgren.

Hur togs då sändningarna emot av bilträffsdeltagare- och arrangörer? - De flesta tyckte att det var ett trevligt och kul inslag, säger radiochefen Martin Björkman. Vi fick också med Partille Närradio - Radio 88 - som gjorde bra PR för programmet. Tyvärr var P4 Göteborg inte lika intresserade....

Allt material sändes från en dator med en spellista som innehöll bland annat material från Radio Nord och inspelningar från DX-entusiaster. Radio 88 bidrog också med ett inspelat specialprogram. Sändningarna gav blodad tand och redan på måndagen efter sändningshelgen skickades en ny ansökan till Mediemyndigheten. Radiohistoriska Sällskapet i Västsverige, som står bakom Radiomuséet, har nu fått ett närradiotillstånd för frekvensen 981 kHz och lovar att återkomma med fler sändningar.

Comments from Andrew Brade regarding Svern Martinsen's article "1983: Fra Kilmallock, Éire til Sheffield, England. 1548 Radio Hallam".

I read the article in MVE 65-22 concerning Svern's visit to Sheffield. My wife is from Sheffield. We got married in Sheffield and our wedding reception was in a hotel less than 300m from where Svern stayed. His hotel, the Sharrow View Hotel, like Radio Hallam, is no longer there!

It's an amazingly detailed account of events more than 40 years ago. I didn't realise that the article was written in Norwegian until I tried to translate it. He says that the person he met at Sheffield Interchange (the bus station) paid his bus fare to Psalter Lane. At that time, buses in Sheffield were very, very cheap. If you were under 16, the maximum fare was 2p. For adults, the maximum was 10p. The bus conductors had little machines which issued tickets for 2,4,6,8 and 10p! I still have a few of those tickets. There was a rule that if the bus ran across the city, passing through the city centre, you had to buy a second ticket, but it still meant that you could go anywhere in Sheffield for no more than 20p.

At the time I read the article, my wife (Debbie) was in Sheffield visiting her mother. Debbie thinks she has a Radio Hallam badge somewhere, which would date from 1983 or earlier (she and I were 19 years old in 1983 - she left Sheffield for Leeds in 1983). Sheffield, like most big cities, has changed a lot since 1983. Even the railway (Sheffield Midland) and bus (Sheffield Interchange) stations mentioned by Svern have changed considerably. I remember them both well. I grew up in Stoke-on-Trent, the home of the British pottery industry. In those days you could get a "local" bus from Stoke to Sheffield, a distance of around 75km. I did it a few times and it arrived at the Interchange.

Sheffield was the home of British steelmaking, and is home to the mighty River Don engine.

https://youtu.be/R331o_Ar56s?t=361 Now in a museum, this engine was used for rolling steel plate. It can go from full forward to full reverse speed in just a couple of seconds. Electric motors could not do this until (relatively) recently, which is why the River Don engine remained in service until long after other steam engines had been scrapped. Happily it was preserved. You can see the direction reversal in the video.



Attached is a photo of my wife's Radio Hallam badge. She is not interested in radio now, and was not then. She cannot remember how she came to have the badge! But she was born in Sheffield and grew up in Sheffield.

I wrote to Svern and got a nice reply. The article was originally written by Svern for a local newspaper. It was very good to read of his experiences.

Can you get anything "useful" out of this far too weak recording. May 12th. at 01.59 UTC 1370,002 I would say.

It should be "southern". The only one I'm used to hear there is CW137 Radio Regional, but that one has "always" been very low somewhere at 1369,850. I can't find any carrier there, but I don't think this is Regional...

(Google translation): For some time now, the AM station formerly known as "AM Trece-70" (AM 1370 KHz), has changed its name, now identifying itself as "AM 1370, LA RADIO DE LATINO ONCE", which apparently is being managed by the owners of the Disco "Latino Once", a dance establishment located in the Once neighborhood, in the Autonomous City of Buenos Aires. This station has been on the air for several years, first broadcasting as "AM Cosmos" on 1310 KHz, and then moving to the current frequency of 1370 KHz, where it changed its name to "AM Trece-70".

The radio station was registered in the Media Census implemented through Resolution 001-AFSCA/09, and its studios were also located in a nightclub, but in this case located at 3747 Cristianía Avenue, in the town of Isidro Casanova, La Matanza District, Buenos Aires Province. Its owner and general manager was Mr. Alberto Villalba, and all its programming was produced by the company "Land Producciones S.R.L.", which broadcast popular music from the Province of Santiago del Estero, better known as "Guaracha". It is estimated that it is still active from its Transmitter Plant at San Juan Bautista de La Salle Avenue 2050 in González Catán, La Matanza District (CG: 34°45'40.0"S, 58°39'16.0"W), where it operated with an Adema AM TX-502 transmitter with a power of 3 Kw, and using a 60 meters high folded monopole antenna. It is estimated that the new name of this station possibly coincides with a change of owner, since the former AM Trece-70 has had its Web Page <www.la1370.com.ar>, its E-mail: <am1370@yahoo.com.ar>, and its Fixed contact Telephone: (11) 4694-6499 inactive for some time.

I think I can hear something like "24 horas ... éxitos .. amplitud modulada AM mil-3-70 la radio <words> Latino Once, siempre con vos".

The correct text is: "24 horas reproduciendo éxitos. Todo el tiempo a tu lado, AM mil-3-70 la radio oficial de Latino Once, siempre con vos".

The station occasionally gives a Whatsapp number 11 37 01 55 83 - 11 is the Buenos Aires area code. I think that to use this number from outside Argentina one would dial +54 9 11 37 01 55 83.

The station plays almost continuous music of the guaracha santiagueña and chamamé styles. IDs are **very** infrequent. It airs a few advertisements, at present for the forthcoming elections but mainly for the 2025 Fiesta Grande del Señor de los Milagros in Mailín which is both an annual religious event and night-time party, held over three days in the small village of Mailín in Santiago del Estero. The celebration happens forty days after Easter each year. I remember hearing ads for this a year ago on other stations with buses being organised for pilgrims from Buenos Aires to Mailín. Mailín became a place of pilgrimage after a cross bearing Jesus' image was found there. Last year 60,000 people visited Mailín for the celebrations.

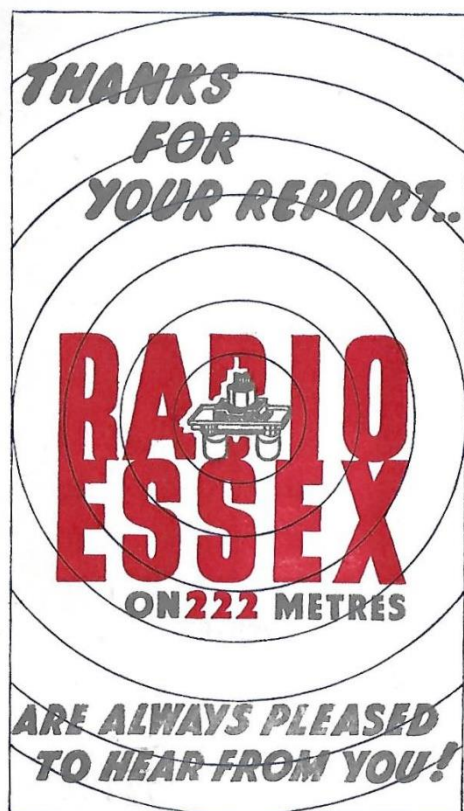

"Sitting in" med Mark Wesley

Hva skal vi gjøre med "Video Nasties", spurte han Mae fra Newmarket, som var en av dem han pratet med mellom platene: Mike Oldfields "Moonlight Shadow", Men at Work's "Down under", Rod Stewarts "Baby Jane", Tracey Ullmans "They Don't Know" og ELOs "Rock n' Roll is King". *Do you Ban 'em or what. What can you do about it?* Lytterne fikk så si sin mening om dette alvorlige spørsmålet.

Mark fikk også alle de store nasjonale samt de lokale avisene brakt inn til seg i studio. Et TV-apparat gav ham de siste nyhetene fra tekst-TVene Oracle/Ceefax. Clare kom inn med et innslag som het Scrapbook, og Frank hadde en hagespalte.

Teknisk prat med Mike Brown

Nevnes må også Mike Brown, Chief Engineer, som hadde sendt meg QSL et halvår før. Han gav meg en god innføring i samsendingssystemet mellom 1251 Saxon i Bury(senderanlegg Great Barton³) og søsterstasjonen 1170 Radio Orwell i Ipswich(senderanlegg Foxhall Heath⁴). For at 1251 og 1170 skulle kunne ha helt lokal identitet også ved fellesprogrammer, var det nødvendig for selskapet å sørge for at Radio Orwells ID ikke ble hørt på Saxons frekvenser og vice versa. De to stasjonene sendte også en del separat, men når Saxon ikke sendte egne programmer kunne den likevel identifisere som seg selv og sende egne reklameinnslag. Men sign on og sign off ser ut til å ha gått // på begge stasjoner⁵.

Mike Brown hadde bygget systemet på basis av ITC tredekks cart-maskiner. Fellesprogram kunne sendes både fra Bury eller Ipswich, og metoden var å mate to cart-maskiner med separate innslag og/eller ID, se på total lengde for begge innslag, og dessuten måtte en instrumentaljingle plasseres nederst i den cart-maskinen som hadde kortest innslag. Denne spilte fram til det lengste innslaget var ferdig og fadet så ut helt automatisk. Presentatoren var da klar til å begynne igjen på begge kanaler med samme program som altså hørtes ut som to forskjellige stasjoner. Det hele ble utløst ved å aktivere "Split" på mikserpanelet.

Her bygget man på et liknende system som allerede var i bruk på 666 Devonair Radio i Exeter og 954 i Torbay, hvor hvert område hadde sin unike sound, og alle reklameinnslag, identifikasjoner o.l. bare ble sendt ut i separate utgaver. Ved bestilt annonse bare for Exeter, for eksempel, hørte Nord-Devon bare denne, mens fylkets sørlige deler hørte en for et firma i Torquay, o.l.

Et liknende system hadde man i Canada, der en moderstasjon kunne ha flere "twins" på AM og/eller FM utover på landsbygda. Disse sendte for det meste "morens" program, men ved "Legal ID", som stasjonene der borte måtte sende, ble separate IDer for stasjonene ordnet ved to eller flere cart-maskiner.

Fredag 8/7 og lørdag 9/7:

ble vesentlig brukt i London, dit jeg kom med toget fra East Anglia om formiddagen den 8.juli via Stowmarket, Ipswich, Manningtree, Colchester, Sudbury, Braintree, Chelmsford, Romford, Stratford og så Liverpool Street station.

Herfra var det lett å ta Central Line på London Underground skiltet Ealing Broadway til Holland Park. Etter en kort spasertur ankom jeg Holland Park nr. 52, Norwegian YWCA, alias KFUK-hjemmet, £11,40 for to døgn på rom 3. Jeg var igjen blant landsmenn - dog mest -kvinner. Etter 5 min. traff jeg endatil en venn og kollega fra min hjemmemenighet Fana, forstander Audun Tang på Haraldsplass i Bergen! Audun var også faren til Elin som jeg traff på CPH under utreisen. Så verden er ikke stor...!

Det ble to fine og varme dager i London med besøk i BBCs hovedkvarter Bush House nær Holborn, Savoy, Strand og Themsen. Her befant seg utenom BBC World Service et lokalradiokontor med mye interessant stoff.

For å komme til IBAs(Independent Broadcasting Authority)kontorer i 70 Brompton Road, tok jeg undergrunnen til Knightsbridge. Stedet ligger ikke langt fra kjente steder som Harrods, Kensington Gardens, Hyde Park og Buckingham Palace, men her var det ingen som tok i mot i det hele tatt, når man unntar en søvnnig resepsjonist og en voksfigur av Kenny Everett! Ulikt ham hadde han ikke mye å si...Utlagt på et bord lå bl.a. konsesjonssøknadene til ILR Norwich og Great Yarmouth(1152 Radio Broadland) og East Kent(603 Network East Kent, den senere Invicta Radio), og det jeg leste satte tankene i sving:

ILR hadde mange gode sider. Den politiske prosessen sikret god samfunnsstyring, og store eierkonsentrasjoner var umuliggjort helt til 1990. Lokale aviser ble sikret innflytelse som aksjeeiere.

IBAs reklameregler var meget detaljerte og gode, og jeg tenkte alt da velegnet til å adoptere også for oss her i Norge om Statsråd Lars Roar Langslet sitt nærradioeksperiment skulle utvikle seg til kommersiell radio. Adskillelsen mellom reklame og programmer var i begynnelsen ganske rigorøs, men ble etterhvert lempet noe på, slik at reklamen ikke lenger hørtes ut som et fremmedelement i programmene.

Likevel kunne det se ut til at stasjonene ble forhindret i driften av altfor rigorøse regler.

IBA eide dessuten alle senderanlegg fram til Radio Authority kom inn i bildet 1990 og spesielt de største stasjonene måtte betale en klekkelig leie for bruken av dem.

Det syntes også som uheldig bare å ha en stasjon i hvert område. Men at Suffolk Radio Group(over)fikk etablere en stasjon til i Bury 6 år etter starten av den første i nabobyen Ipswich tydet jo på at en oppmykning var på vei.

For bare én stasjon pr.konsesjonsområde(unntatt London)førte til at en god del kreativitet og talent gikk tapt selv om en del talenter også fant veien til BBC. Og ILR-stasjonen i et område måtte ta hensyn til alle smaksretninger i musikkrepertoaret, og alle synspunkt for eksempel på det religiøse område slik jeg alt hadde sett det på Radio Hallam.

Jeg hadde også avtale om å besøke ulisensiserte og profesjonelle 1323 Radio Jackie i Sørvest-London, som på denne tiden sendte 24/7 i døgnet, og nå så ut til å være ignorert av myndighetene, men på grunn av mangel på tid ble det ikke noe av.

Kl. 19.15 lørdagen gikk mitt tog fra Euston med endepunkt Sealinks Irlandsferge i Holyhead, Nord-Wales. Jeg tok meg fram via "The Tube", men det var meget varmt og børen var tung.

Da toget kom i gang, var det igjen mye å se, Watford, Milton Keynes (en av de såkalte «new towns»⁶), Rugby, Stafford, Crewe, Chester, gjennom «the Marcher country», der 1260 Marcher Sound var i anmarsj

med tester. I Wales passerte badebyene som perler på en snor: Flint, Prestatyn, Rhyl, Colwyn Bay, Llandudno, Conwy Bay, Bangor og så endelig: Holyhead.

Underveis: Radio, med senderanlegg som Daventry, Lichfield og stasjoner: 828/792 Chiltern Radio, 1107 BBC Radio Northampton, 828 BBC Radio WM, 990 Beacon Radio, 1152 Piccadilly Radio, 1458 BBC Radio Manchester, 1548 Radio City, 1485 BBC Radio Merseyside, 855/1557 BBC Radio Lancashire, 999 Red Rose Radio.

Søndag 10/7

var den siste dagen på reisen, og den ble innledet med lang venting på kaien i Holyhead. Men 03.15 la «St. Columba» fra kai bound for Dún Laoghaire, Co. Dublin. Jeg traff igjen Dave Coughlan fra RTE som hadde vært CE på byggeradioen i Kilmallock hvor jeg hadde hospitert. Han syntes at alle de ulisenserte stasjonene skulle tas inn i varmen, men alle burde kunne greie seg med samme frekvens... Ellers tollfritt og lotteri midt på natten. Søvntrukne mennesker satt overalt og ble forsøkt overtalt til å kjøpe lodder med £1000 som premie. Ganske komisk forresten. Jeg sovnet. Det neste jeg hørte var at gevinsten må hentes – for nå var piren i Dún Laoghaire (*anglisert utt. Dunleery*) rett forut.

Så var det buss til Dublin city centre. Der ble det gatevandring en stille søndagsmorgen siden jeg gikk glipp av morgenmessen. Jeg lengtet til Bud og Hustad kirker... *Liksom hjorten stunder etter bekker med rennende vann.... (Salme 42,2 ff)*

Tok tidlig flybuss til Dublin airport. Der brukte jeg mine aller siste penger til et måltid mat, med 88.3 Radio Nova i toppform på Grundig Music Boy 400 med "American Country Countdown" og senere "American Top 40". David Malone leste nyhetene denne morgenen.

Endelig, 14.20 lettet SAS sin flyvning SK538 med en DC-9-40 for CPH. Noe overvektig i følge kapteinen. Både speidere fra Portlaoise og "Peace People" fra Nord-Irland (Nobels Fredspris 1976) var med. Jeg satt ved siden av deres ledere. En trivelig prat og tur ble det.

Så venting i København. Går ikke SK868 snart? Første stopp KRS/Kristiansand. Jeg så gamle «prestetomter» på LTS Kjevik og det koselige Espegrenhuset vi fikk bo i da. Det var blitt 5 år siden. Gode minner fra Forsvaret og Tveit menighet. Tiden flyr...

Måtte den fly fortære.

Fly fortære da SAS! Er det Ulriken vi ser der til høyre?

Endelig. BGO. Bergen. «Jeg tok min nystemte cithar i hende.» Eller var det en radio? I allefall-der står Tvillingene og Torhild! (Slutt.)

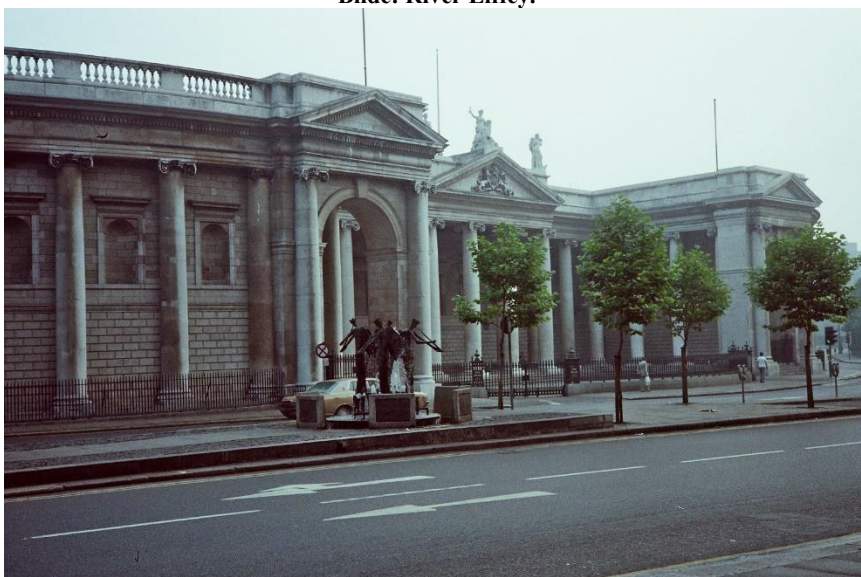

History of Radio in Costa Rica (69): Ecos de Poás

Tetsuya Hirahara

Ecos de Poás was a station located in Alajuela. "In November 1936, don Carlos Videche, a visionary from Alajuela, founded the first radio station in Alajuela, Radio Ecos del Poás. Afterwards, the station was left in the hands of Mr. Perry Girton, founder of La Voz de la Víctor, and then Radio Ecos del Poás passes to the Martínez Johnson family." (Panorama Digital, 30/8/2022)

Its beginning is not clear but the station was already in operation in August 1936. A lot of advertisements began to appear from 1939. May be in this period, Emilio Martínez obtained the ownership. They inaugurated a new plant on July 15, 1940.

As of 1953, the station had callsigns TIJJM. I'm sure they derive from Emilio's farther Juan José Martínez Galvez. They remained on the air up to 1957, when they were renamed to Radio Progreso.

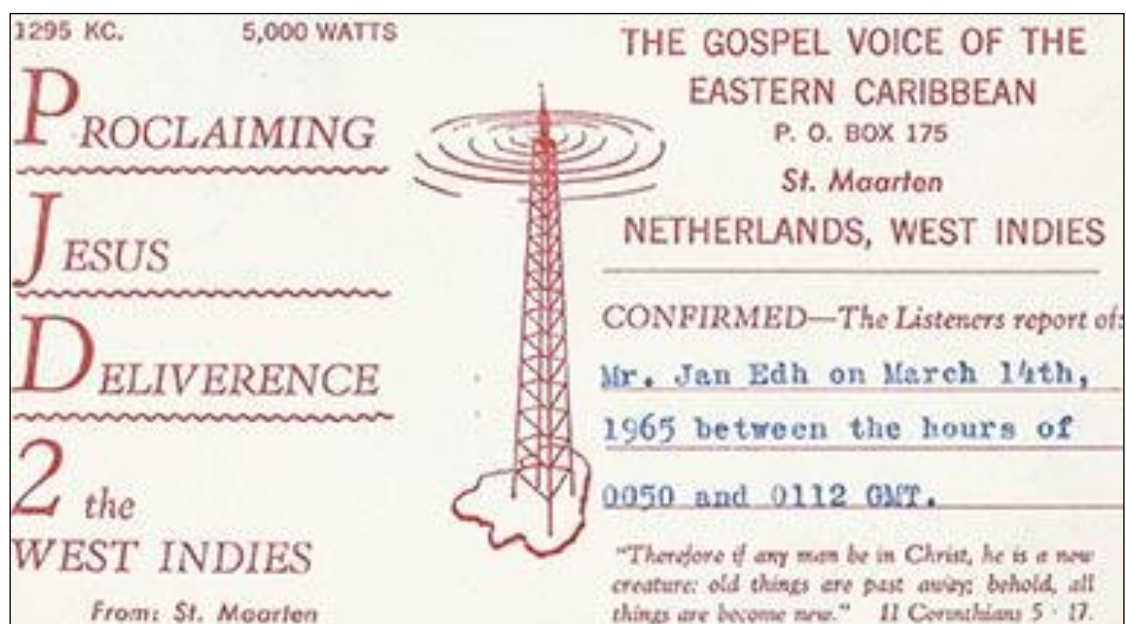
