30/1 Ingen inspelning

31/1 lät 285-gradaren annorlunda jämfört med senaste tiden. En hel del NA och med bra styrka fram till efter 00 UTC. CBG på 1400 har knappast hörts alls den här säsongen, men dominerade nu helt. Före 01 var dock nästan alla NA borta - nu var det R Nacional, Buenos Aires på 870 och R Nacional Asunción på 920, Svaga spansktalande lite "här och där". 03 mest NA igen men också tilltagande brus och redan efter 05 började signalerna försvinna.

1/2 var det nästan bara NA, men också brusigare igen och därmed svårt med id. Anmärkningsvärt dock att Seattlestationen KNWN gick hyfsat på vår 285-gradare. Runt 00 fanns några peruaner också, men lite för svagt för att ta sig genom bruset.

2/2 färre NA signaler och kanske också lite mer störningar än dagen innan. Mot morgonen allt mer spansktalande på högre frekvenser. Bland annat fanns det några peruaner, som hade varit riktigt intressanta om inte störningarna hade omöjliggjort det.

3/2 Stationer på de flesta kanaler, åtminstone när man började komma över 800 kHz, men med en störning i botten som tvingar upp signalerna till åtminstone -85 dB om det ska finnas någon möjlighet till id i de flesta fall, blir det inte så mycket ändå. Få av vad som kan kallas "intressant" når upp till den styrkan Deppigt att få ut så lite när det är sådana kalaskonditioner mot NA.

4/2 var först fram mot 01 som det började gå en del Puertoricaner, men svaga signaler. 02 var det också Colombia på flera frekvenser, liksom att det började gå några vanligare peruaner. Efter 04 också en hel del östkust-NA men också allt mer störningar

5/2 hade solen "spottat upp sig" igen men jag låg kvar på 285 grader. Inte bra. Harbour Light var ensam om att gå någorlunda stabilt under natten. "Det mesta" (NA östkust, Puerto Rico, Colombia), som i det här fallet inte var mycket, gick med svaga signaler, än sämre och brusigare mot morgonen.

6/2 blev det inte alls lyckat efter byte till den ojordade 255-gradaren. Få signaler och svaga signaler. Någon brasse (med fotboll) vid 00-01. Lite blandat resten av natten men ingenting bra och inget till synes intressant.

7/2 fanns det en del svaga signaler från Brasilien under tidiga natten, men blev bättre vid 02 och ett par timmar framåt. Också några från Argentina. Runt 04 signaler också från några Uruguay och Paraguay men de flesta alldeles för svagt. Väldigt magert på högre frekvenser.

8/2 var det antagligen fel att ligga kvar på 255-grader, men det kanske inte gjorde något för det var väldigt mycket brus och sprak. Någon brasse och Paraguay på 920 och 970. Men mot morgonen var det Colombia på t ex 1580 och 1590, Canada på 590 och 1140 och Grönland på 570 och 650...

Ronny Forslund 11.2.2026:

Trots antensituationen i Fredriksfors går det fortfarande att gräva fram en hel del med litet gnetande. Men det tar tid. Vi har fortfarande brusmattan att kämpa med. En sak som jag har märkt är att 285-gradaren drar betydligt längre västerut än tidigare efter haveriet/reparationen. Så det kunde vara värre. Jag har också god hjälp av Rutan att komma upp och kolla bandet varje natt. Hon är noga med att säga till i god tid innan heltimmen och det konstiga är att hon verkar ha koll på kondsen, precis som hon har koll på tiden. När hon inte säger något alls har K-index ofta skjutit i höjden och knappt något hörs. Men när hon puffar på mig extra energiskt vet jag att något är på gång. Hon är också noga med att påminna mig om andra saker som behöver göras. Ja, det är allt tur att någon har koll....

Stefan Wikander 13.2.2026:

Äntligen lite bättre konds. Den 31:a januari och 1:a februari var det korta stunder riktigt bra. Har inte gjort annat än korta kollar av senare datum men det verkar fortsätta att höras NA. De dagar när det snöar eller är rimfrost begränsas hörbarheten rejält och bara starkaste stationerna orkar över koronabruset från kraftledningarna.

Kallt har det varit. Ner mot minus 30 grader i flera dagar i sträck vid fyra olika tillfällen nu i början av året uppe vid lyssnarstugan. Fick passa på att åka upp och ladda batterierna en dag när det bara var minus 8 grader. Har fått köra ganska mycket extra tid för att hålla uppe temperaturen inne i boxen där jag har min utrustning. Batterierna klarar ändå upp mot 15-20 dygn innan de måste laddas. Batterierna till radiogrejerna som är inne i box med radiogrejerna blir sällan mera än någon enstaka minusgrad. De batterierna tar åt sig 8-10 ampere direkt när jag börjar ladda medan batterierna som stått ute i stugan och kanske är minus 15-20 grader kalla bara tar åt sig 2 ampere. 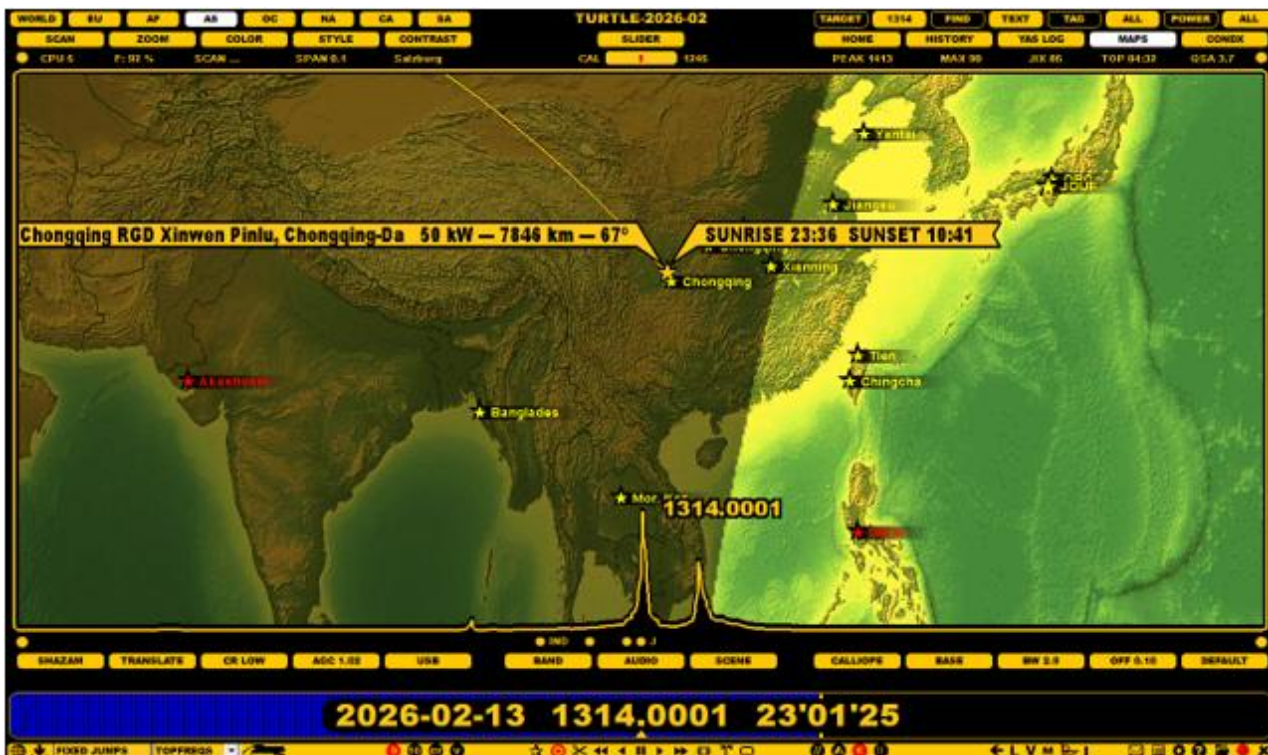

In addition, the spectrum of Jaguar Software has been improved in the current v12 test version, and the display speed has also been improved. The software is an important component for medium wave, and I can only recommend the v12 version to everyone. Let's hope for more good signals in February!

WLW Cincinnati OH

Ray Crawford in Toowoomba, Queensland sends along an image of the WLW Cincinnati Ohio AM operation in 1934 – a view from the operator's desk, looking towards the Western Electric transmitter, which served as a driver for the 500 kW transmitter at WLW. According to theradiohistorian.org website which has an extensive photo gallery of the installation, WLW became the first and only United States AM station to operate with the massive power of 500 kW. It was a huge investment on the part of Powel Crosley, Jr. WLW operated at this power level under an experimental license until 1939, when Congress and the F.C.C. decided that the maximum power for any broadcaster would be 50 kW. The massive transmitter has sat idle since 1939, but is still in place today in WLW's Cincinnati facility.

Australia

The Nine Radio network, talk network comprising **2GB Sydney (873 AM)**, **3AW Melbourne (693)**, **4BC Brisbane (882)** and **6PR Perth (882)**, plus music stations **2UE Sydney (954)**, **3EE Melbourne (1278)** and **4BH Brisbane (1116)** has been sold to an entity linked with publican Arthur Laundry.



Between 1938 and 2020, the Nine Radio entity was known as the **Macquarie Radio Network**. 85 year old Laundry is said to operate more than 40 hotels. His children include former Federal Liberal Minister Craig Laundry, suggesting the talk radio network's conservative political orientation would continue under the family's ownership. Laundry senior, who is said to be worth \$1.75 billion, has not previously been linked to the deal. In recent days, it was expected that Craig Hutchison, of the Sports Entertainment Group (including SEN sports radio in Australia and NZ's Sport Nation operation), would be the buyer.

ABC Perth, West Australia, news for c/o date.

The ABC has confirmed the date for its switch to FM, according to the following post from the **ABC Perth Facebook page**:

ABC Radio listeners in Perth will experience significantly improved audio quality, from February 23, when **ABC Radio Perth** switches from **720 AM** transmission to 102.5 FM (100 kW).

ABC AM services will continue in regional and remote WA areas and the move to FM in Perth will not have an impact on the ABC's commitment to emergency broadcasting or Parliament broadcasting.

Radio National 810 AM, will also make the switch, to 103.3FM (100 kW) and **ABC NewsRadio** will be found on 104.1FM (100 kW).

The **ABC Radio Perth** and **Radio National AM** services will cease shortly after our FM broadcasts are fully operational.

6PB – ABC Newsradio will stay on the air and simulcast on AM/FM. **6PB** is also part of the **ABC** network so tax payers would still foot that bill. The other 2 stations will switch off on April 6th, following a six week simulcast period. I checked yesterday if there were already FM signals in Perth on the proposed frequencies but didn't hear anything on the Perth FMDX Webserver. It is amazing to see how empty that FM band is in Perth for such a large metropolitan market (2.3 million people).

France

Bretagne 5 could be heard on **1593 kHz** across a significant part of western Europe during the night, until early november 2023 when they suddenly disappeared from MW and were never heard again. Only an extremely weak carrier could be detected, probably (DF bearing) from the Romanian stations that also transmit on **1593 kHz**. Some months later, **Bretagne 5** was no longer listed on MWlist.org. However, their website made no mention of the failure and still advertised **1593 kHz** MW as their frequency. In september 2024, the Arcom (French broadcast authority) renewed **Bretagne 5**'s MW license for 5 years, starting on April 20th, 2025. Source: <https://www.legifrance.gouv.fr/jorf/id/JORFTEXT000050475774>

The **Twente WebSDR** waterfall archive (<http://websdr.ewi.utwente.nl:8901/fullday/>) shows that, on every date until November 1st, 2023 (inclusive), a strong signal is present all night long on **1593 kHz**. On November 2nd, 2023, such a signal is initially present but **stops at 3:19 UTC**, leaving only another, very faint signal visible. Then a strong signal starts at 3:44 UTC, fades out with sunrise, fades back in with sunset and stops at 2003 UTC. On all the following nights, a strong signal fades in with sunset, goes off around 2000 UTC and back on around 3:45 UTC; this matches the **Romanian** transmitters' schedule. But the disappearance of a signal at 0319 UTC on November 2nd is a unique pattern, and no station is scheduled to sign off at that time. This is however consistent with the date of disappearance of **Bretagne 5**'s signal. Furthermore, no issue with the **Romanian** transmitters was reported at this period. On that night, there was storm Ciaran, winds up to 207 km/h were observed in Brittany (Pointe du Raz), the peak of the storm occurring between 3 and 4 UTC (source: <https://www.ouest-france.fr/meteo/tempete/la-tempete-ciaran-commence-fort-en-finistere-des-rafales-de-vent-a-150-km-h-deja-relevees-b6cf9680-78e0-11ee-8fc9-410e7fd09adf> – times in this source are UTC+1). This storm is known to have caused considerable damage.



We can conclude that **Bretagne 5** went “silent key” on **November 2nd, 2023, 3:19 UTC**, due to that damage. However, on the the satellite images of Saint-Gouéno transmitter taken in May 2025 and published in January 2026, the 45 m tall antenna is still standing and apparently intact compared with the previous images from 2021. Therefore, the nature and extent of the damage cannot be determined from this sole information. Are there any other examples of a station unexpectedly closing down against their own will, by accident? **Bretagne 5** was the last French MW station. There is a **1467 kHz** transmitter in **Roumoules**, but it is extraterritorial and the programmes are not in french. Therefore, the only French station broadcasting in AM is now Radio France International (RFI) on shortwave. Since the closedown of Bretagne 5 was not scheduled, it is very unlikely to have been recorded as audio. However, I have an audio clip that I recorded in October 2023; please let me know if you are interested.

India

All India Radio begins two-hour morning Gurbani broadcast from **Golden Temple, Amritsar**. **AIR, Jalandhar**, has been airing kirtan from the **Golden Temple** for three hours daily on MW, including a two-hour morning slot from 4 am to 6 am. **All India Radio (AIR), Amritsar**, has begun broadcasting full two-hour early morning Gurbani from the **Golden Temple**, a move widely welcomed by listeners.

The service, initiated by Prasar Bharati from January 13, enables devotees in **Amritsar, Tarn Taran and Gurdaspur** districts, as well as listeners across the International Border in Pakistan, to listen to the sacred kirtan. Since the launch of **AIR, Amritsar**, on September 24, 2018, the station had been broadcasting Gurbani from 5 am to 6 am. The FM transmission gets relayed from **AIR's Gharinda** village centre near **Attari** and is operated under the **External Services Division of AIR**. Besides Gurbani, the division also airs special Urdu and Saraiki programmes, which has audiences in **Pakistan**, too.

Meanwhile, **AIR, Jalandhar**, has been airing kirtan from the **Golden Temple** for three hours daily on MW (medium wave), including a two-hour morning slot from 4 am to 6 am. Former engineer Harjap Singh Aujla, who had been spearheading the demand, said medium wave transmissions were often unclear in distant areas and had also lost relevance as the use of MW radio sets declined. "FM transmission offers better sound quality and is free from signal shadow caused by high-rise buildings. Residents of four border districts of Amritsar, Tarn Taran, Gurdaspur and Pathankot will now be able to listen the full Gurbani (two hours) clearly on FM," added Aujla. He expressed hope that **AIR, Amritsar**, would also start the evening Gurbani broadcast from 4.30 pm to 5.30 pm, on the lines of **AIR, Jalandhar**. Kulwant Singh Ankh, patron of the Amritsar Vikas Manch, said many people still preferred listening to Gurbani on the radio. Even in Lahore, several listeners tuned into Gurbani rendered in classical ragas, including noted Punjabi poet Ustad Daman, who was known to listen to kirtan regularly, he said. Satnam Singh of Dhotian village said listening to the morning kirtan on the radio was like a daily act of worship for him.



The demand for Gurbani broadcast on radio dates back to the period of the Dharam Yudh Morcha in 1982. After Operation Bluestar in June 1984, **AIR, Jalandhar**, began relaying shabad kirtan from the **Golden Temple** for three hours daily. Bhagwant Singh Dhangera, manager of the Golden Temple, said, "It is encouraging that devotees can now listen to Gurbani for two hours. Many people prefer radio over television for kirtan as Gurbani is considered more of an art to be heard than watched."

NHK Radio 2 is to close on 31 March. **NHK** operates two national AM stations; it was decided to close **Radio 2** in 2021. **Radio 2** was specifically funded as an educational radio station, with language courses and other educational programmes - like “Junior High School Basic English Level 1 & 2” and “Radio Business English”, “Portuguese for Beginners”, “Time for Religion,” and “Visual Impairment Navi Radio”.

NHK has been slowly moving some of the educational and language programmes from **Radio 2** over to **NHK**'s FM station, and to **NHK Radio 1**, which will continue on AM, though it'll get a new name.

New Zealand

On 14 February, Lower Hutt will get a **new radio station** following the granting of a low power AM licence on **1449** kHz at 25 Watts. At this time I do not know what the content will be or whether it will relay another service, but I have been informed that the **1449** kHz will broadcast in wideband C-QUAM AM Stereo with up to 10 kHz of audio. The transmission is set to commence at midnight on 13 February. There will be some improvements as time goes on so dust off your C-QUAM receivers, and remember that most Japanese import cars are fitted with C-QUAM receivers. Online KiwiSDRs decode C-QUAM by selecting QAM mode. (Tim Moore)

The Government has agreed to extend New Zealand AM and FM licences for another 20 years, beyond their current expiry date of 2031. The Government is also selling additional licences which had previously been set aside for a national youth channel – opportunities for major players such as **NZME**, **MediaWorks** and others to open new battlegrounds in main centres. According to the most recent GFK audience survey, radio attracts around 3.327 million listeners per week, a number that has remained broadly stable over the past 12 months. “AM and FM radio is an important source of news and information for many New Zealanders,” Media and Communications Minister Paul Goldsmith said. “It also plays a crucial role in emergency broadcasting. “By extending the spectrum licences that underpin our radio networks until 2051, we are ensuring that the operators – whether they are large commercial networks, independent stations, or regional, community or iwi networks – can continue to broadcast.”The decision to extend the licences – there are currently 1053 across New Zealand, almost 900 of them FM – follows a period of public and industry consultation in 2025. In a statement on Tuesday evening, the **Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE)** said commercial, community, and iwi broadcasters would continue to have access to radio spectrum. It said commercial licence holders – such as **NZME** and **MediaWorks** – could expect renewal offers in mid-2026, and would have six months to consider them. Renewal offers would be based on a national value of \$29 million for the current commercial licence-set. “This means the per-capita price paid will be lower than was consulted on in 2025, reflecting industry feedback and information provided through the consultation,” the **MBIE** statement said.

BBC returns to **702 kHz** for Iran.

The **BBC World Service** has launched a temporary emergency lifeline radio programme for Iran in response to the ongoing turmoil in the country, and the unprecedented crackdown on protests. To complement the existing **BBC News Persian** video and digital services, the radio programme will be available on mediumwave and shortwave across Iran to increase the population's access to news and information. To broaden its offer and availability of programming, the BBC World Service has also made some of its TV content available on mediumwave radio.



Since 8 January, the Iranian people have been subject to an internet blackout. Prior to this, **BBC News Persian's digital services** saw their biggest reach in a year with their platforms reaching more than 33 million people. The short-term programme will cover the latest news and developments in Iran and will place events inside the country within their wider regional and international context. It will feature voices from inside Iran alongside clear, informed analysis of the most recent political, social, and economic developments shaping the situation in the country. The programme will air daily for 30 minutes across medium and shortwave frequencies from 4.30pm GMT / 8pm Iran Standard Time. The temporary programme has been granted resource from existing funds until the end of March 2026. The **BBC World Service** has a history of launching emergency services in times of crisis. In April 2025, **BBC News Burmese** started providing audio and video content on a satellite channel in the aftermath of Myanmar earthquake. In April 2024, following the fall of the Assad regime, the **BBC World Service** set up an enhanced audio channel on FM and mediumwave for the people of **Syria**. This follows the **emergency radio service for Gaza** in November 2024 and for Sudan in May 2023 amid conflict. It was reported in MV-Eko 66-12 and January's MWN that CNN programming on 950 LR3 would cease on 19th December. It was expected to play music for a while before returning to its former identity as Radio Belgrano in "mid-January".

The end of CNN on 950 after six years occurred, as anticipated, at 0400 on 20th December. After the witty insertion of a football referee's full-time whistle, music started with the announcement "Una nueva radio está llegando - StreAM 950". You can hear the end of CNN here <https://uk.radiocut.fm/audiocut/lr3-am-950-final-cnn-radio-argentina-y-comienzo-stream-950/> .

Listening today on LU4EEC's KiwiSDR, the station is playing a mix of music - from excellent retro ska "Calaveras y Diablitos" by Argentine band "Los Fabulosos Cadillacs" to "I don't like Mondays" by the Boomtown Rats (NB no use of Shazam or any artyfishul intellygence, just Mk.1 human ears). The station identifies (not too frequently) as "StreAM 950". In fact I heard the same ID mentioned above that followed the full-time whistle.

Radio Nacional del Perú, the state-owned broadcaster, has withdrawn from the AM band without much fanfare. A source connected to the station indicated that the withdrawal from this band occurred at the end of last year.

We requested an interview with a station official to learn the reasons for this decision. However, the Radio Directorate refused to provide direct information and stated that inquiries should be channeled through the Transparency Office. They further specified that interviews are only granted with authorization from the relevant departments, which determine which official should respond to the matter. As of the time of publication, we are still awaiting an official response.

Radio Nacional del Perú's abandonment of the 850 kHz (OAX4A) and 1320 kHz (OAX41) frequencies is also reflected in the National Frequency Registry of the Ministry of Transport and Communications (MTC), where both frequencies appear vacant, that is, blank.

Over the last few decades, AM (medium wave) radio in Lima has been losing ground. Many stations migrated to FM or established themselves solely on digital platforms; others, however, simply disappeared. Nevertheless, AM is still fighting the good fight.

Currently, there are 22 stations on this band in Lima. Most are evangelical radio stations belonging to different denominations. The largest group, not only in the religious sphere, is Radio Bethel, which owns more than 300 stations across the coast, highlands, and jungle.

595/605/601 On November 8th, 1942 during "Operation Torch" a special US broadcast station aboard the battleship USS Texas (BB-35) in the Mediterranean went on the air with 5 kW on 595 kHz. The frequency was chosen to interfere with and overpower local Moroccan stations. It blasted a pre-recorded message from President Roosevelt in both French and English announcing the arrival of the Allied Forces as liberators. There will be more in a special essay about this station and AES(above) which may be seen as the forerunner of Allied and especially American Broadcasting in the field.

And then it's over to veteran and founder Gene Richardson who the author heard from in 2006:

My name is Eugene Richardson and I built the station WNAAⁱⁱ. It started out as an audio output, then the first transmitter was a modified Collins TCS-12 15 watt. I was pleased to find someone after all these years who had an interest in the things we did as young people. The station for the first two years was a singular event. I designed, purchased parts, made the entire station solo. It was turned on at 6:00 AM and turned off at 12 Midnight. Seven days a week 18 hours a day with no help. The only thing to come of this was a commendation for my effort.

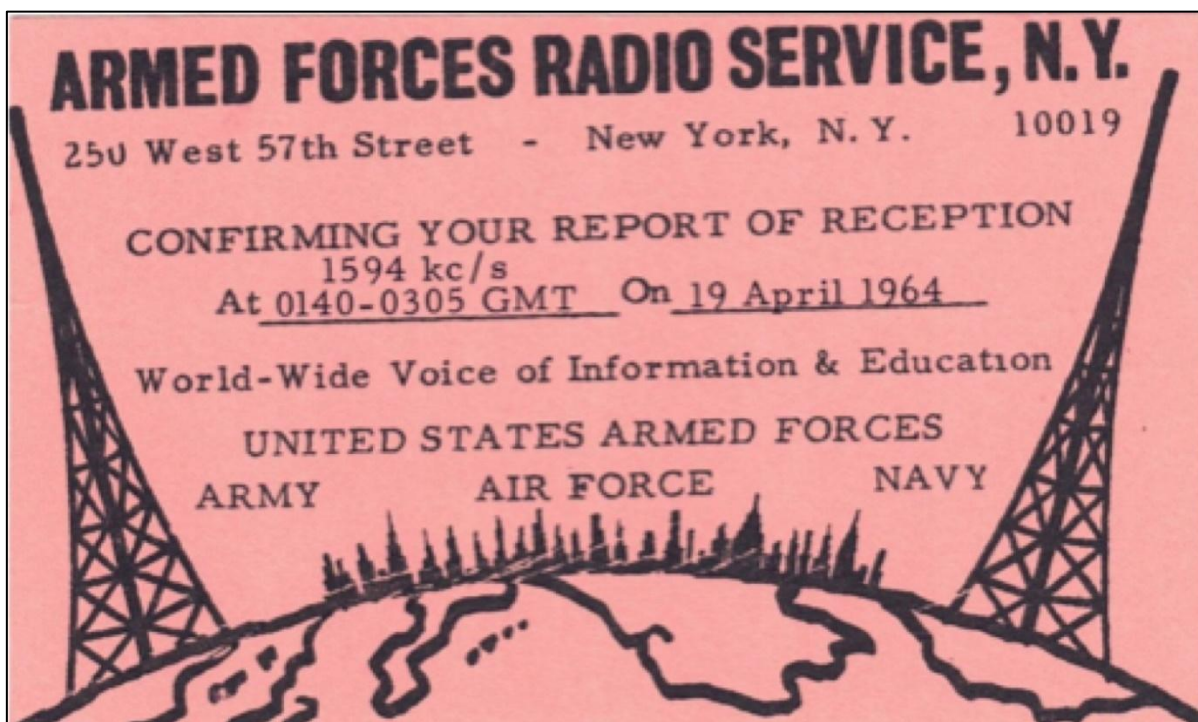

When the Italians surrendered, first British and then US forces moved into Asmara and set up Radio Marina on the grounds of an Italian utility radio station in January 1942.

1000 WOG/AFSA at Radio Marina, later KANU Kagnew Air Base, Massawah, Asmara, Eritrea started April 18th, 1948 with 50 watts. Sche: 0330-2400. Later went to

1500(1958) Changed to

1475 Dec.29th, 1967. 250 watts. 1972- 1 kW. Some fine receptions noted in Scandinavia from 1968. Heard in Norway all seasons between 1970 and 1973 usually after the Spanish SER stations such as Radios Rioja, Zamora, Asturias, Santander, Cordoba and Elche closed, The author had KANU on July 30th, 1971 at 0200. I remember monitoring the signal on many nights after this when the 1475 channel left KANU clear, with AFRS programming, syndicated shows and baseball. It had deep fades, but fine peaks. I went through the MW Horizons bulletin 1970-1973 and found 4-5 logs of the station in addition to myself: 3 were by Torgeir Woxen(TW), one each by Øivind Stenberg(ØS), Kai Mauseth(KM), Arvid Frøslund(AF) and the late Per Ingebretsen(PI). Only ONE QSL to Norway and that was in 1970 season(TW, May, 1971.) TW also listened on September 14th, 1971 at 0122 and October 16th, 1973 at 0140. Ronny Forslund(RF) also remembers hearing it: "Jag vet att jag skickade en rapport och det bör ha varit 1972. Jag minns inte om jag skickade den till en APO-box eller direkt till basen." Intet svar. From found, undated 1973 log: Moody Blues, Jackson 5, Carpenters, Mott the Hoople, also country show: "Country Music Time"? "All American Radio." Last noted logging was DAM/Dario Monferino in Italy on 070374.

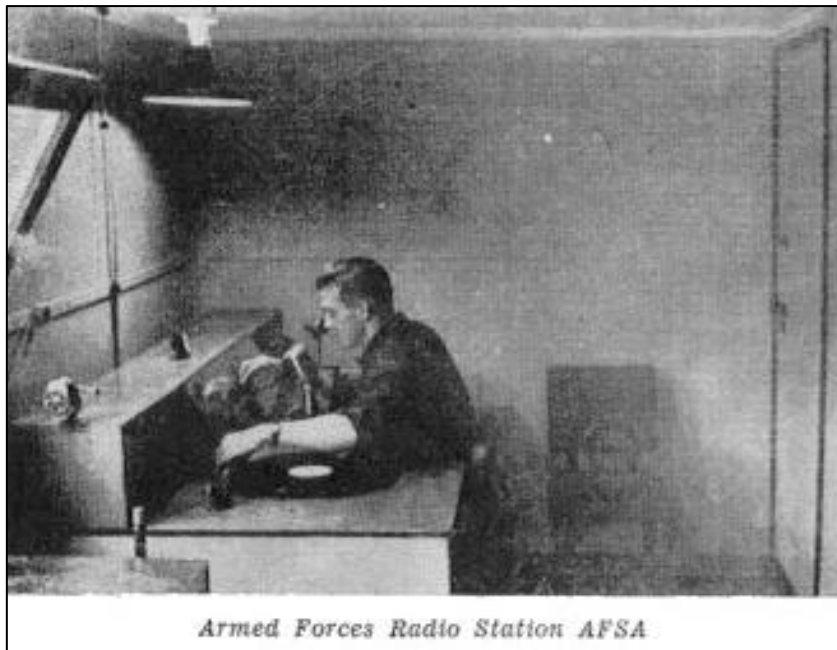

From WA5IEX Roland Richter in Texas, 2004:

"I have greatly enjoyed reading your collected history of these stations.

"---a note about AFRS Asmara,.... I was there in Summer 1972 through December 1973. We received many reception reports from above the Arctic circle. It was a very efficient transmitter site with a 1 KW Gates BC-1H transmitter, quarter wavelength tower and extensive ground system in Asmara at about 7200 foot elevation above sea level. In 1973, we experimented with very aggressive audio processing to give very full, very loud modulation so the signal would have really stood out. We had a Gates Sta-level amplifier followed by a Gates SA-39 tube type limiter at the studio compressing about 15 db, then at the transmitter a Gates Solid Statesman Limiter with another 8-10 db of peak limiting set up for asymmetric modulation...about 95 % on negative peaks and consistently about 125-130% on positive peaks. The Gates transmitter used 833A tubes (2) in the final high level plate modulated by 2 more 833A's in push-pull. This resulted in a very punchy, loud signal for the amount of power, especially because at the time European stations used very little audio processing, very little compression.

The FM was on 95.1 MHz with a transmitter output power of 50 watts, feeding a 4-bay circularly polarized antenna about 120 feet above the ground. This gave an effective radiated power of about 75 watts in the vertical and horizontal planes taking into account transmission line loss. The coverage was phenomenal however because we were on a 7200 foot high plateau. The FM signal was easily audible in Massawa on the Red Sea coast, though it faded some driving down the mountain road...."

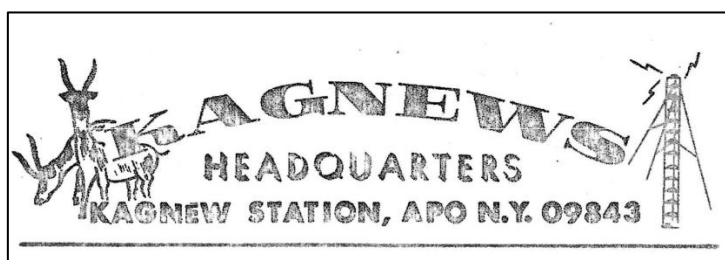

History of Radio in Costa Rica (83): Radio Paramount

It is presumed that Radio Paramount (1195 kHz) was inaugurated in 1954. Manager-Owner was Enrique Carvajal Arias. At least, the station stayed on the air until January 1958.

According to its publicity, their antecessor was Radio Central, which transmitted on 1195 kHz in 1948. (cf. No.75 of this series.)

A former DXer in Lobsterland – en fortsättning



I föregående nummer av MV-Eko presenterade Ronny Forslund en intervju med Richard Ringenback, Operations Manager på Newstalk WLOB Portland ME-1310 kHz. Efter att ha fått en kopia av MVE där intervjun fanns, skriver Richard följande:

”My Dear Ronny:

My apologies for not replying sooner, but I had work duties. I received the pdf version of "MW Echo" with the article on myself, including my answers to your questions. And all I can say is...

WOOOOOOOOOOOOOOOWWWWEEEEEEEEEEEEEEEEEE!

YOU DID A MAGNIFICENT JOB! I LOVED IT!

Especially since you didn't delete anything. I printed out the article and shared it with my employer here - he was crazy about it. What was most interesting (and I don't know how you retrieved it) was that trade magazine display ad for WLOB from 1957 promoting the Lobster Radio Network, which was nothing more than a sales rep agreement among many stations in the state at that time. Mel Stone was WLOB's first manager, and its studios were originally in the old Columbia Hotel in downtown Portland, which has since been demolished; WLOB moved out to its current address in 1960. I never knew Mel, but his business partner, Fred Miller, gave me my first salaried broadcasting job in late 1977; Fred bought the old original WLOB-FM from Mel around 1974, moved it, and gave it a different format.

Lastly, I was astonished at the amount of tech data and station trivia in "MW Echo"! And thanks for mentioning Maine's beloved annual Maine Lobster Festival, held every August in the town of Rockland. My own parents went there way back in 1950.

Thanks again, Ronny, for the wonderful job. To all of you over there - 73s and God bless.”

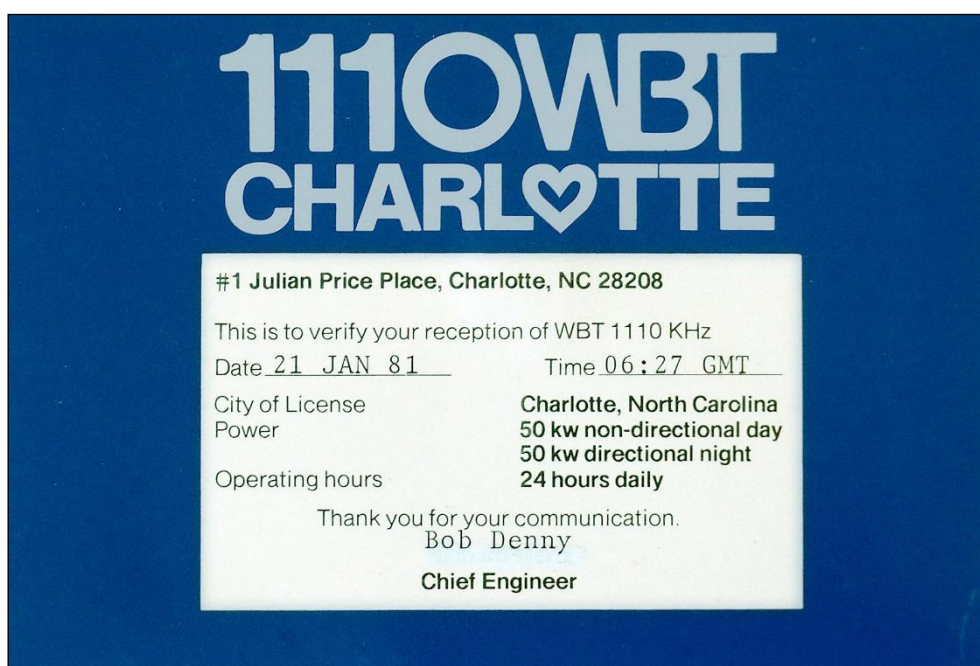

Hjärtligt välkomna till detta nummers nostalgispalt! Ingen aktiv mellanvågslissnare kan väl ha missat att WBT 1110 i Charlotte, North Carolina flyttat över till FM? Dock har stationen legat kvar med en slinga där lyssnarna ombeds att slå över till FM 107.9. Det har spekulerats i om företaget bakom WBT möjligen skulle byta till annat format på 1110. Men nu verkar stationen ha lämnat mellanvågen helt. Den 12 februari hördes slingan för sista gången i Fredriksfors men mycket dåligt på grund av kondsen. Ett par dagar senare hade KFAB i Omaha, NE tagit över frekvensen. För säkerhets skull har jag när detta skrivs den 15 februari 2026 kollat över ett antal Kiwimottagare i NC och på 1110 kHz finns ingen signal alls.



Vi får se om WBT 1110 återkommer i någon form men just nu verkar stationen vara helt borta på mellanvågen. WBT har ju under åren varit känd som en riktig "flamethrower" och har för det mesta dominerat frekvensen. Med sin status som clear channel-station var WBT en av de vanligaste NA-signalerna på våra breddgrader. På hemsidan wbt.com nämns nu enbart FM-frekvensen.

WBT startade redan 1922 och var därmed en av de äldsta radiostationerna i USA. Innan dess hade man sänt som en experimentsändare med signalen 4XD. Det var tre radioamatörer; Fred Laxton som jobbade för General Electric, Earle J. Gluck, ingenjör hos Westinghouse och Frank Bunker som var anställd hos Southern Bell Telephone Co. som startade 4XD. Det vanliga vid denna tid var att radioamatörer använde gnistsändare men Laxton lyckades från General Electric få fram ett ovanligt elektronrör som möjliggjorde talsändningar. Sändaren installerades i ett tidigare höns hus bakom Laxton's hus i Charlotte och en kabel drogs till en mikrofon inne i vardagsrummet. Från sporadiska testsändningar där Laxton's dotter fick sitta och räkna högt i mikrofonen avancerade man till att så småningom börja spela musik från grammofonskivor. Initiativet uppskattades av den breda allmänheten och i december 1921 såg företaget Southern Radio Corporation dagens ljus. Man fick en licens för 360 meter (833 kHz). Vid denna tid fanns två frekvenser att välja mellan: 833 kHz (360 m.) för underhållning och 619 kHz (485 m.) för marknads- och väderrapporter. I mars 1922 startade sändningarna från the Realty building i Charlotte med callen WBT (QSL säger den 10 april). Stationen såldes 1925 till Buickhandlaren C.C. Coddington och callen kom då att uttydas "Watch Buick Travel". Coddington sålde 1929 stationen till nybildade CBS Radio Network.

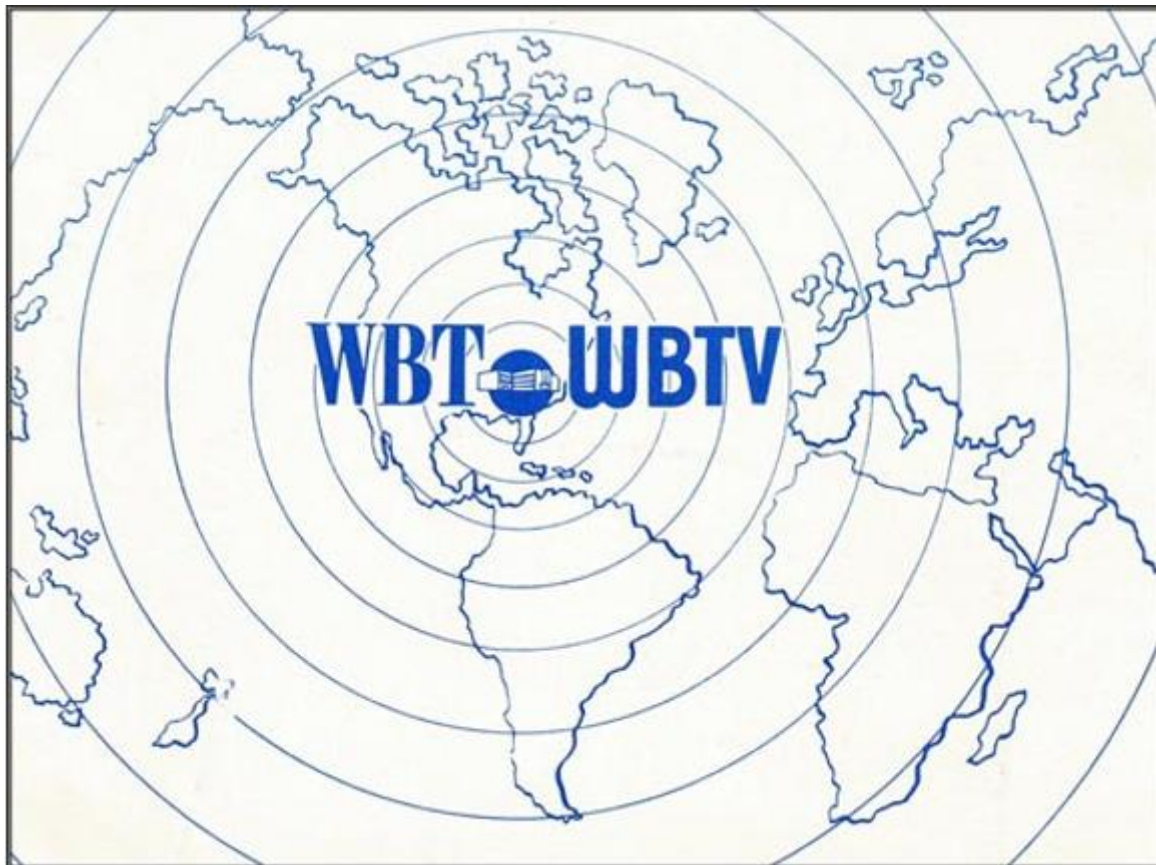

Arthur Smith & His Crackerjacks var husband på WBT och många menar att program som "Briarhoppers" och "Carolina Hayride" inspirerade The Grand Ole Opry på WSM. Arthur Smith är väl mest känd för låtarna "Guitar boogie" samt "Duelling banjos" – en klassisk bluegrasslåt som vi alla minns från filmen "Deliverance" ("Den sista färden" på svenska). Jag vet inte vad ARC:s egen countryspecialist Tore Larsson TL hörde när han rapporterade WBT 1961 men så här såg i alla fall QSL-brevet ut som han fick.

Thank you for your reception report of February 8, 2026. We are always pleased to hear from our distant listeners. Your recording was clear enough to confirm you were hearing our 35,000 Watt Day/42,000 Watt Night 780 KHz signal.

WBBM was originally licensed in 1923 to 226 meters at 500 watts in Lincoln IL. Ralph Atlas, the owner then moved the station to the Chicago area in 1924, eventually changing to 770 KHz in 1927, and again to 780KHz in 1941. WBBM has had various formats from WBBM Air Theater, to the Showmanship Station, to Talk of Chicago, and has been "All News" since 1968.

WBBM-AM broadcasts from studios in downtown Chicago, with transmitter facilities in suburban Glendale Heights. We currently use a GatesAir 5DX50 transmitter as our main, and a Harris 3DX50 as our backup transmitter. These transmitters are coupled to either our guyed 226 meter main antenna or our 75 meter self-supporting antenna.
