Jan Edh 8.4.2026:

26-30/3 ingen inspelning.

31/3 fanns det signaler från Brasilien redan före 22 och även på högre frekvenser trots att det knastrade mycket där. Sedan alltmer La Plata men med kläna styrkor, dock en liten bättring mot Argentina vid 03. 04 framför allt starka signaler från de vanliga puertoricanerna, men också några peruaner och colombianer.

1/4 fina signaler på en del brassar redan 22 (31/3) som 610, 1070, 1150, 1230, 1340, 1470 (2) 00 var det Argentina-Zambia i fotbollslandskamp som märktes på t ex Radio Nacional 870, 1150, 1300, 1310. Efter hand allt mer blandat, framför allt på övre bandhalvan, med inslag av Peru, Colombia och Venezuela, men inte många stationer som gick riktigt bra.

2/4 blev en ganska misslyckad natt – kanske hade 285 grader varit ett bättre antennval? En klar försämring mot Brasilien och La Plata, det mesta som gick var Colombia, Venezuela och Puerto Rico, men inte särskilt bra. Samtidigt bröts mönstret av Chile på 1100, 1140, 1180, troligen också 1000 och 1270.

3/4 en ganska ”besvärlig” natt. Det verkade som många stationer ”bara” spelade musik. Dessutom var det överlag svaga signaler, som ibland fadade upp till fina styrkor under korta stunder. Svårt att få id på stationerna med andra ord trots en hel del ”nötande”.

4/4 tog den starka solstörningen sin tribut. Kraftigt knaster över mellanvägen. En del starka brassar och några få La Plata-stationer kom igenom, men de flesta för svagt och dessutom med illa distorerat ljud.

5/4 åter en förbättring, framför allt mot La Plata. Många starka signaler på stationer som plötsligen känns ”vanliga” efter de stundtals fina konditionerna mot sydligaste Sydamerika i vår. Men dåligt på höga frekvenser med svaga signaler och kraftiga störningar.

6/4 trodde jag att den starka solstörningen gett med sig och bytte till 285-gradersantennen. Det var ett dåligt beslut. Bara några få signaler som gick att tyda på hela natten, ingenting som inte bör ha gått väsentligt bättre på 255 grader. Knappt några bärvågor som inte bör ha varit Brasilien eller La Plata.

7/4 lite bättre signaler på en del La Plata (Argentina främst) på låga frekvenser. Fortsatt mycket dåligt från ”nordligare” trakter. Ideal 1190 bröt möjligen mönstret med att gå hyfsat.

8/4 ännu en helt misslyckad natt. Inte förrän vid 0230 började det dyka upp lite signaler, då i första hand vanliga från Colombia på högre frekvenser. Vid 0330 rätt många stationer från Colombia och Puerto Rico men också Bahamas 1540, Monumental 1510 och Carravis 1570 t ex. Men mycket fading och distade signaler. 04 fanns bara någon enstaka Puertorican kvar. Inget som helst NA.

Australia's biggest private radio network has been put up for sale for the first time in 40 years after an alleged feud between siblings.

Daily Telegraph Confidential:

Australia's biggest and most mysterious private radio network is for sale for the first time in 40 years. Confidential can reveal **Super Radio Network (SRN)**, the company behind Sydney's **2SM 1269**, is looking for a buyer, with hopes of achieving a sale price as high as \$200m.

It is understood the sale has been prompted by the disintegration of the relationship between co-owners and siblings Despina Priala and George Caralis, the children of **SRN** founder Bill Caralis, who died of a heart attack in July 2024 aged 81. Insiders say the pair haven't been on speaking terms for the last year, with contact sometimes limited between lawyers.

Dan Tepper of KPMG has been appointed to sell **SRN**. He is well known for selling Janet Cameron's Grant Broadcasting group of regional radio stations for a staggering \$300 million to the ASX-listed Australian Radio Network. It comes days after the departure of chief executive Rhys Holleran and **SRN** announcing a new boss: Graham Mott, formerly of **Nine Radio**.

SRN, or **Broadcast Operations Group**, has a massive network of mostly regional radio stations. The broadcaster's biggest markets include Newcastle, Bathurst, Tamworth, Dubbo, Taree, Lismore and Tweed Heads. **SRN** stations are in markets where radio broadcasting remains strong with audiences. A further strength for the business is that the Caralis family owns not only the radio frequency licences but also an extensive portfolio of properties, including transmitter sites and spare land. The Caralis' hold some 50 stations and employ roughly 200 people.

Sydney is a jewel in the crown, where **2SM** is based out of a large headquarters in Pyrmont. **SRN**'s Tweed Heads offices are also a significant asset for the business. "It has been in the works for a long time," a long-term staff member told Confidential. "Their late father would be heartbroken to see it get to this. Bill was fiercely proud of the network he built and to see a split in the family that is seeing it sold up is tragic. George wants to modernise the company, invest, and make a go of it and Despina has different views, so they're getting out." y up to date with the Daily Telegraph. Despina runs her own legal business based on the Gold Coast. George has worked in the family company since he was a teenager. He's now in his 50s. "He has a good feel for radio". One country station manager said: "This has been a family company for so long, we have no idea what the future could look like." On Friday, Confidential revealed Holleran had exited the business after just a few months in the job.

KNDI 1270 Honolulu goes off. Beloved multilingual radio station drops off AM dial.

A multilingual station that has served Hawaii’s immigrant communities for 66 years, has gone dark on the AM dial.

KNDI radio, a multilingual station that has served Hawaii’s immigrant communities for 66 years, has gone dark on the AM dial after being forced to vacate its transmitter tower, leaving hosts and listeners scrambling to reconnect.

The station had been broadcasting from a tower in **Kalihi**, and says it still had three years remaining on its lease when it was told to vacate by Dec. 31 of last year, citing safety concerns. The land under the tower is owned by the state Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, which has not described the specific safety concerns. Station executives say they do not plan to sue and are instead focused on raising money to install a new transmitter at a tower in Mapunapuna. Hosts say listeners, especially elders, left without a signal.



KNDI host Flor Martinez, who has been on the air for decades, said the loss hit him hard. “I was devastated. For so many years that we had been in the air and all of a sudden we are not there anymore,” Martinez said. “Our responsibility to our audience, to our people listening to us, as if we have betrayed them and it’s so sad.”

Hispanic-language host Rolando Sanchez said listeners were left confused by the sudden disappearance. “They had no idea what’s going on, what’s happening, and all of the station, we have a problem,” Sanchez said.

“We’re on the air. We’re not. We’re here. We’re there.”

Host Ernie Bautista said he has been fielding calls from listeners who can no longer find his program. “I don’t want my listeners confused. (They) keep calling me, ‘How can I get into your program?’” Bautista said. He said he has been directing listeners to the station’s Facebook page as an alternative. “If they cannot find me on the regular program, AM, FM or whatever, you can always join me on Facebook.”

AM signal offered statewide reach

The station’s AM frequency provided statewide coverage because low-frequency AM signals travel farther than FM and can penetrate physical obstacles, making the band particularly valuable for emergency information. The station launched a new FM site last year at frequency 104.7, and it is continuing all its programming, but its audience is shrinking, which means lower advertising revenue.

The station’s youngest host, Bryan Munoz said they didn’t have enough notice to stay on the AM band. “We were heartbroken because it was like abrupt and we had to do what we could to keep things going,” Munoz said. “But a lot of people miss the AM.”

Station seeks \$500K to restore signal

KNDI went on the air in 1960 with an all-female lineup as a short-lived attention-getter. The station is known for its Filipino hosts and programming but also carries regular content in multiple immigrant languages. Between music, hosts share medical advice, community events and even funeral announcements.

The station broadcasts from a rented house on South King Street and operates on a modest budget. Station executives say relocating the AM transmitter will cost approximately \$500,000. Along with a GoFundMe page for public donations, the station is seeking grants from government agencies and foundations. Sanchez said the community’s connection to the station runs deep. “The dependence of people to have some way of knowing what’s going on, we don’t want it to disappear,” he said. 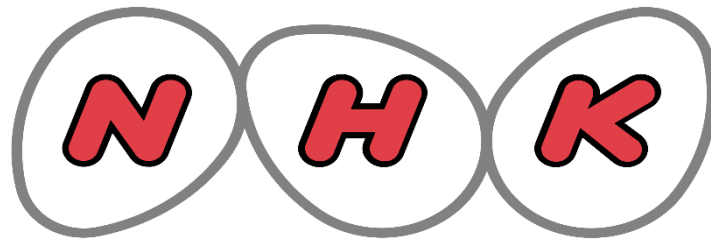

Most of the programs of **R2** will be transferred to "**NHK AM**"(former **R1**) and "**NHK FM**" after 30 March 30, except; Arabic Lesson, News in Thai/Chinese/Korean/ Vietnamese (to online only), Stock Market Reports, "Easy Japanese"(to **NHK World Radio Japan**) and other 4 programs.

The transmission licenses of all **R2** stations (including 4 500kW sites - **Shobu** (Tokyo) **693** kHz, **Ebetu** (Sapporo) **747** kHz, **Ogata** (Akita) **774** kHz and **Otsu** (Kumamoto) **873** kHz) will be expired after 1 April 1, 2026. **NHK** says they will save 37 billion yen for the next 20 years by ending **R2**.

Major AM Changes Coming For Auckland New Zealand

A major broadcasting shake-up will start in Auckland New Zealand in mid-April, as a project gets underway to start dismantling the 2 **RNZ** transmission masts at **Henderson** in **West Auckland**. The northern and southern masts are 91 and 70 years old respectively. In all, 15 radio stations rely on them for their AM services.

There are 8 on the 122 metre high northern mast in Sellwood Road – **Radio Waatea** on **603** kHz, **Humm 702**, **BBC World Service 810**, **Chinese Voices 936**, **Newstalk ZB 1080**, **Rhema 1251**, **Radio Tarana 1386** and **Radio Samoa 1593**, and 7 on the 153 metre high southern mast at Lincoln Road – **531PI** on **531** kHz, **RNZ National 756**, **Parliament/Sanctuary 882**, **APNA 990**, **Ake 1179**, **Gold Sport AM 1332** and **Sport Nation 1476**.

Since Friday morning, **BBC World Service 810** has been broadcasting a message each hour announcing that after 35 years on the Auckland airwaves, they will close down at midnight NZT (1200 UTC). Press reports indicate that a total of 6 stations will be leaving the Auckland AM band to enable transmissions to be eventually trimmed back from 2 masts to one. Besides **BBC World Service**, press reports have identified others departing AM as Pacific Media Network's **531pi**, **Gold Sport 1332** and **Sport Nation 1476**. I anticipate these closures on the northern mast will enable **RNZ National 756**, **Parliament/Sanctuary 882** to be transferred from the southern mast, pending the planned construction of a new single mast at the northern site.

At this stage the sixth planned AM departure has yet to be confirmed, but my guess is that it could be either **APNA 990** or **Ake 1179**. We do know that **531pi** is to be allocated an alternative FM frequency for 5 years (previously protected for a possible **RNZ Youth Network**).



RNZ has made the call to dismantle both masts and rebuild a new one on the northern site – this would meet **RNZ**'s transmission needs, including the vital emergency broadcasting functions, said **RNZ** chief technology officer Mark Bullen. He said “**RNZ** has a primary responsibility to prudently use its funding to create public media content for audiences. That means we need to ensure all infrastructure investment is affordable while also providing the best value to New Zealanders. **RNZ** is not established as an infrastructure provider to other broadcasters who have independently secured AM licences from the Crown”.

Work on decommissioning the ageing infrastructure and building the new mast in **Selwood Road Henderson** starts later this month. **RNZ** will eventually sell the commercially valuable southern site in **Lincoln Road, Henderson** after removal of the mast. In recent years **RNZ** had tested an alternative new South Auckland transmission site at Awhitu on the shores of the **Manukau Harbour**, but this appears to have been flagged due to budget cuts by the Coalition Government.

Russia

MW still in service.

The **RTRS Far East Regional Centre** still operates a network of synchronised transmitters broadcasting on **756 kHz** to cover the territories of **Khabarovsk**, **Kamchatka** and **Chukotka** with the station **Vostok Rossii** (Russian Far East).

This synchronised network comprises medium-wave transmitters at **Berezovy** 5 kW, **Bikin** 5 kW, **Bogorodskoye** 5 kW, **Chegdomyn** 5 kW, **De Kastri** 5 kW, **Khabarovsk** 20 kW, **Komsomolsk-on-Amur** 20 kW, **Krasnoye** 20 kW, **Nikolayevsk-on-Amur** 5 kW, **Troitskoye** 5 kW, **Tsimmermanovka** 5 kW, **Vyazemsky** 5 kW.

This is a unique example in Russia, given that all broadcasts in this band have been discontinued for budgetary reasons. There are several reasons for this exception: the region's specific characteristics, its greater autonomy from Moscow, and the desire of the **Ministry of Information** of the **Khabarovsk Territory** to reduce the influence of foreign radio stations broadcasting in Russian.

A major modernisation programme, planned for nearly ten years, has been delayed. Officials planned to convert the entire medium-wave broadcasting network to digital format. According to them, "this change should increase population coverage by 10 to 15 per cent and significantly improve broadcast quality. They hoped that with 'digitisation', the percentage of broadcasting coverage would rise to 98 per cent".

The regional government wanted to go even further and use shortwave to cover remote areas. The system was to comprise two 50 kW transmitters capable of operating from 4.21 to 10.48 MHz. The horizontally polarised antennas would be directed towards **north-eastern Russia**, the **Sea of Okhotsk**, the **Bering Strait** and the **Far North**.

In March of this year, the project was revived: specialists from the **RTRS Far East Regional Centre** launched a major upgrade of the broadcasting network of the **Vostok Rossii** radio station in **Khabarovsk Krai**. The installation of new equipment has begun at broadcasting centres in **Bikin**, **Vyazemskoye**, **Kotikovo** and other towns in the region.

The modernisation of the network is being carried out on the initiative of the **Khabarovsk Krai** government and the **Ministry of Digital Development and Communications**. The details of this modernisation are not known, but according to the authorities, it will significantly expand the station's coverage area and improve signal quality for residents of the region.

It is planned to commission 55 FM broadcasting stations between November 2026 and December 2027. Will they finally digitise the medium wave band, keep it as it is, or replace it with FM? What about the shortwave project?

Radio Vostok Rossii is the last remaining large MW station in Russia. They broadcast on **765 kHz** from various sites from **Khabarovsk Region** in the Russian Far East, which is 788 thousand square km, more than twice the size of Japan.

In Tokyo, as **YBS Radio** (Kofu, Yamanashi) on **765** kHz and **NHK-R2 Akita** on **774** kHz (500 kW) were gone in March 2026, **765** kHz has been a clear channel since the beginning of April. Then I can receive this Russian MW station with good reception in early evening hours (around 1000UT). It's been a really long time since I last listened to the Russian station on MW!



As E-mail address of this station is not made public, I asked it on the “contact” form at their home page. They soon informed me of the address. I sent reception report in Russian with receiver screen and sample recording to this address, they promptly replied with eQSL in pdf format. As the staff of this station understand English, reception reports in English may be also accepted.

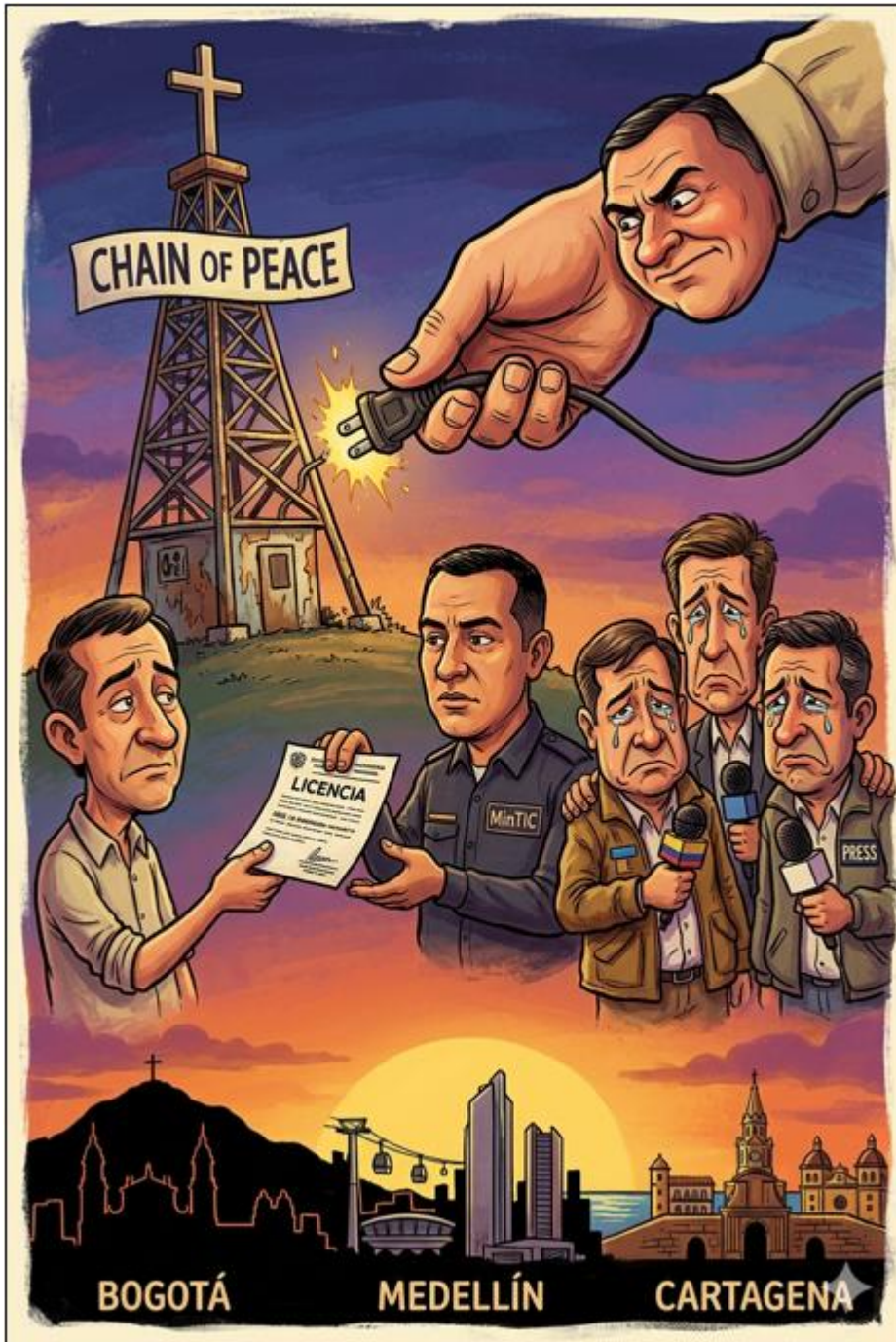

An era in Colombian broadcasting is coming to an end



Colmundo Radio, a staple of the airwaves for over 40 years, is officially going off the air. The network's history began in 1981 when it was founded as Grupo Radial Colombiano by the Rodríguez Orejuela brothers. During its early years, it was a media powerhouse that recruited top-tier talent to dominate the ratings.

In 1989, the network underwent a major transformation when it was sold to Pastor Chamorro, an Ecuadorian politician and religious leader who rebranded it as Colmundo Radio. Often called "La cadena de la paz" (The Peace Chain), it became a primary platform for the Student Crusade Church and Christian programming.

Due to the decline of AM radio listenership and the rise of digital platforms, the network has decided to return its licenses to the Ministry of Information Technologies and Communications (Mintic).

The closure affects operations in the following cities:

- * Bogotá (Main Base)
- * Medellín
- * Cartagena

All of these stations operated on the AM frequency band. Currently, the stations have replaced their standard content with music as they prepare for the final shutdown, impacting over 50 journalists and staff members who now face an uncertain future.

History of Radio in Costa Rica (87): Radio Omega

Radio Omega began test transmission in December 1971, succeeding a part of the facilities used by the legendary La Voz de la Víctor on 625 kHz. The owner was the famous engineer, Roy Jimenez. Their original plan was to commence the service in March 1971 with a power of 25 kW.

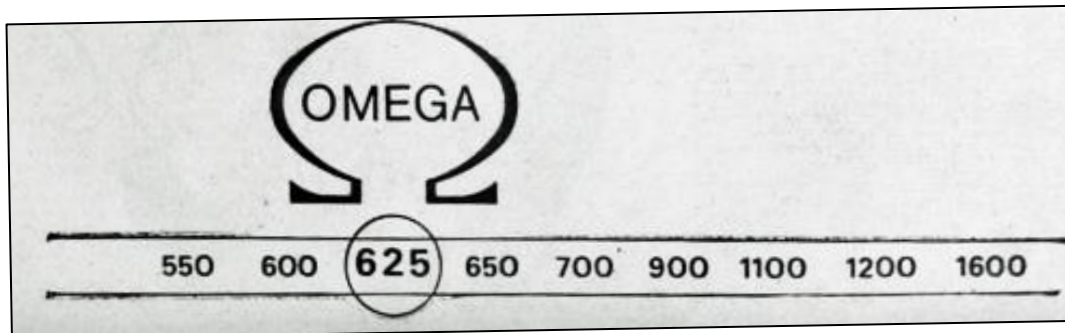
In August 1974 it was reported that they would increase power to 50 kW.

In March 1976, Radio Millón conducted test transmission with 1000 kW on 625 kHz, maybe using the silent time of Radio Omega.

By 1981, the station went off the air, but the exact date is unknown.

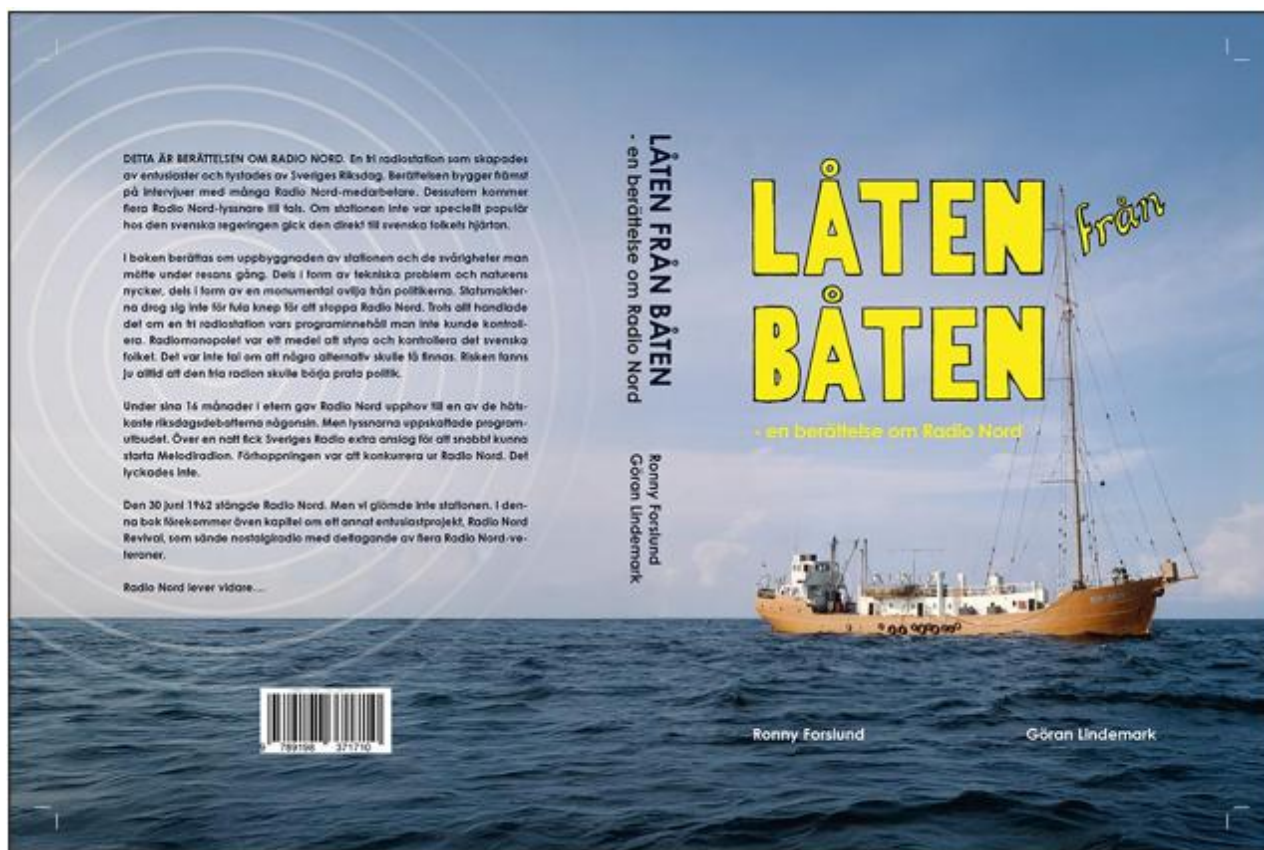

Ytterligare ett offshore-radio-relaterat brev ur Lars Rydén's samling. Detta brev är synnerligen intressant om man känner till något om den brittiska piratradiohistorien. Stationens ägare Reginald Calvert skriver att stationen finansieras genom att han säljer reklam under musikprogrammen på dagtid vilket ger honom möjlighet att sända kristna program. I själva verket var det precis tvärtom! Radio City sände de religiösa programmen med en svag sändare på 1605 kHz i utkanten av mellanvågsbandet medan popsändningarna gick ut över huvudsändaren på 1034 kHz. Det var en oerhört lönsam affär att sända program som *The Revival Hour*, *The Voice of Prophecy*, *The Wings of Healing* och *The World Tomorrow*, som producerades av Worldwide Church of God i Pasadena med Garner Ted Armstrong som programledare. Ungefär 80% av intäkterna kom från religiösa program och alla annonsintäkter var en ren bonus då kostnaderna för att driva stationen väl täcktes av de kristna programmen. Reginald Calvert sköts till döds av en konkurrent, Oliver Smedley från Project Atlanta 1966. Jag kan i sammanhanget rekommendera boken *Life and death of a pirate* ISBN 978-0-9515116-6-4 som skrevs av Reg Calvert's dotter Susan, nu Susan Moore. En mycket bra bok för alla som är intresserad av radio- och pophistoria.



I elfte timman kom ett bidrag in från JOB och TL vidarebefordrade det påpassligt snabbt. JOB kommer att fortsättningsvis bidra med QSL från vår framlidne DX-vän BOS' samling. Vi lämnar över ordet till JOB:

CJSB "54 Rock" fanns på 540 från 1982 till dess att de gick över till FM 106.9 31.8 1994. Nu har de slogan "Jump! 106.9" och callen CKQB. På 540 var den alltid svårhörda minns jag att Bosse nämnde. QSL-brevet som syns i spalten kom efter att BOS loggat dem hemma i Furuögrund 9/12 1987 vid pass 0714 UTC, och det nog nästan dröjde ett år innan svaret dök upp. Han har två svar då det kom på follow-up:en också sent omsider. Först i Sverige var dock Lars Härkönen som hörde dem dagen innan! Oklart om han fick svar, så Bosses QSL är nog en raritet kantänka. Deras chief engineer Jeff Ruck syftar på 580 CFRA, 920 CBO, 1200 CFGO och 1310 CIWW. Av dessa finns ju 580 och 1200 kvar i alla fall. CBO försvann till FM redan 1991 medan CIWW lades ner under 2023. Jag var aldrig nära CJSB på 540 då jag var tämligen grön på NA-DX sådär tidigt 90-tal, och som sagt 1994 lämnade man AM liksom majoriteten av kanadickerna gjort, inte bara på 540...

Thank you for your interesting letter and the reception report and cassette. I listened to the cassette, which I found to be of good sound quality, and can indeed confirm that it is CJSB Radio / 54 Light Rock. The show that you heard was a network show that was run on a weekly basis.

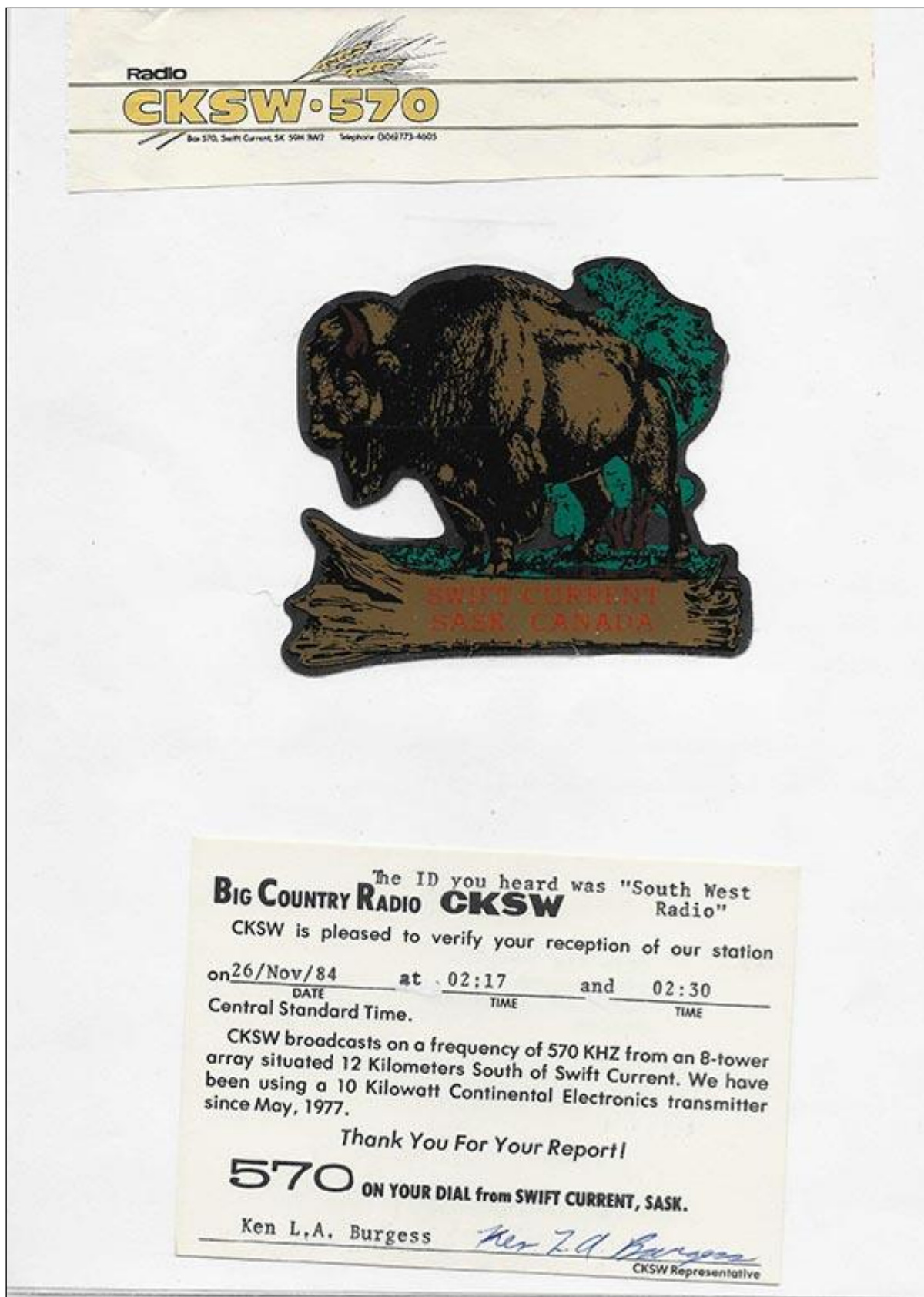
We no longer carry that show as part of our broadcasting schedule and have changed our name to 54 ROCK / CJSB Radio. The format for music is now rock based hit radio, including everything from the Rolling Stones to Led Zeppelin and Robert Palmer.

The technical specifications for the station are one 50Kw Continental Electronics 317C-2 into 4 1/4 wave antennas in a phased array for daytime use, 10Kw into 3 1/4 wave antennas in a phased array for nighttime use and one 10Kw Continental Electronics 316F for stand-by use. Our geographical co-ordinates are 45 degrees 11' 21" N, 75 degrees 46' 46" W.

Other Ottawa stations you might want to listen for are: CFRA 580, CBO 920, CFGO/ENERGY 1200, and CIWW/W1310 at 1310.
