Australia

3NE Wangaratta 1566 commenced their FM conversion on 1 July and 92.1 FM is currently running parallel with AM, which will close transmission at midnight on 27 July. (David Headland & Ian Donaldson 2/7) Just before midnight 27 July, I heard **1566 kHz 3NE** suddenly switch off while airing a Wangaratta bistro ad. **4GM Wide Bay** (Gympie) was immediately audible. (Todd Emslie via ICDX-AM iog) Some changes afoot for the **Racing and Sport Network (RSN)** with news on 9 July that it has been acquired by the **Sport and Entertainment Group (SEG)**, which is the owner of the **Sports Entertainment Network (SEN)**. The deal is worth \$3.25m, payable over three years, and is expected to complete by 1 September.

SEN is purchasing the assets from the Victorian Racing Industry, which includes thoroughbred, harness and greyhound racing codes. According to the media release announcing the deal, the **RSN** assets will be 'integrated into **SEN**'s broader audio and digital ecosystem'. This may lead to some changes to programming. **RSN** currently operates on **927 Melbourne**; **945 Bendigo**; **1260 Shepparton**; **1314 Ballarat**; and **1359 Mildura**, as well as several low power FM channels across **Victoria**. Its principal channel on **927** has a storied history in Australian radio, starting as **3UZ** in 1925 (originally on **930** until the introduction of 9 kHz spacing in 1978).



'**The Greater 3UZ**' dominated the Melbourne radio scene over several decades and fostered the careers of many leading radio and television personalities. Horse racing coverage resumed on **3UZ** towards the end of the 1980s after the station was sold to the racing industry, followed by a rebrand as **Sport 927** in the mid-90s. NZ listeners may recall **SEN**'s short foray into the local market through its **SENZ** network across 28 stations, which were sold to **TAB New Zealand** in 2023 and later rebranded as **Sport Nation**. (Matt Francis NSW via DX Dialog 9/7) **3SR Shepparton** on **1260** AM will rebrand on 1 September as **SEN Goulburn Valley** from **RSN**. **SEN** are also considering what to do with the **Melbourne 1116** spot now that they have acquired the licence for **927 Melbourne**, of **RSN**, as **927** penetrates the **Melbourne** CBD RF noise floor clearer.

China

China Adopts **DRM Standard** to Modernize AM Radio Bands.

China's National Radio and Television Administration announced that it has adopted the Digital Radio Mondiale standard for future use in its shortwave and **medium-wave broadcasting bands**.

The regulator publicly made the announcement on Aug. 1, formally authorizing the use of the DRM standard for digital broadcasting in these bands for China's domestic radio services. The NRTA is a ministry-level regulator that oversees the country's broadcasting and audiovisual services.

On August 18, 2025, approved by NRTA, “**General Radio**” (AM **666 kHz** FM 92.7 MHz) of Jinzhou Radio and Television Station (at Jinzhou, Liaoning province) was renamed to “**News Radio**”. It is commendable that the official press release lists MW frequency **666 kHz** before FM 92.7MHz. Many Chinese stations are now neglecting their MW frequencies, some stations show FM frequency only although they are using MW frequencies in parallel. Jinzhou is the coastal prefecture-level city with the area of 10111 square km (compared to Los Angeles 1302 square km) which is too wide to cover by the single FM frequency. MW **666 kHz** is over #318 transmitter site at Jinzhou with the power of 2 kW, scheduled at 2125-1500UT (in “**General Radio**” era) according to <https://www.asiawaves.net>

On September 1, 2025, **Qinghai Economic Radio** (FM 107.5MHz, AM **1143 kHz**, both frequencies for the Xining, Qinghai province) and **Qinghai Life Radio** (FM 90.3MHz) will be merged to new “**Qinghai Economic and Life Radio**”. The frequencies will be FM 90.3MHz and MW **1143 kHz**. Original information is at “**Xiaolin Broadcasting Station**” site <https://kbysradio.wordpress.com/2025/08/24/>

Xining is the capital city of **Qinghai province** with the area of 7596 square km which is also too wide to cover by the single FM frequency. MW **1143 kHz** is over #560 transmitter site at Xining with the power of 10 kW, scheduled at 2255-1600UT (**Economic Radio**) according to <https://www.asiawaves.net> (*Takahito Akabayashi to WOR iog 27.08.2025*)

Finland

Arctic 252: The Nautel ND2000 transmitter is now ready, the correct crystal oscillators have been found and configuration for **252 kHz** has been done. Audio bandwidth has been increased. The NX2000TUB antenna tuner will be used with the modified beacon antenna. The setting up of the antenna has been delayed but hopefully work will be carried out very soon. Lately the amount of emails to the station asking for start dates has been too many to reply to but advance notice will be given for every transmission even testing. **252 kHz** is not ideal given that **Algeria** is so strong but at present this is all the station has on LW. Permission for another frequency has to be applied for by the radio authority in Finland to the ITU so it's not a simple process to do this. In all work has been slow as there is no help on the ground to do things. (*Mauno Ritola, MWlist iog 10.08.2025*)



Yesterday marked the first broadcast of audio material on **252 kHz LW**. Transmitter is currently running at 600w carrier, 750-800W peak modulation. It will get better over time. Range is only 150 km until we get the proper antenna up in September. So that's it, LW is back in Finland after 32 years. Those who said it cannot be done are proven wrong! (*Matt to Idun's MW-Info 25.08.2025*)

New Zealand

The **Tihiotonga (Rotorua)** AM transmitting site finally closed on 11 July, some 2 weeks later than the 30 June date originally announced. Back on 15 June, David Kaio reported that the RNZ website had a press release stating "On 30 June 2025 RNZ will be retiring its aging AM radio transmitter site at **Tihiotonga**". That date came and went, with commercial users of the RNZ mast - **NewsTalk ZB 747** and **Gold Sport 1350** continuing to air their 'retune message' as I type this on 5 July. Finally on 4 July, after listening for a couple of days, I finally caught an insert announcement by Todd Zayner at 0558, 0658, 0758, 0858 and again at 1858 UTC on 1188 kHz.

The recorded message stated: "RNZ is retiring the **Tihiotonga** AM transmitter serving rural areas of the **Rotorua** district. If you're hearing this message now, you'll be affected. **RNZ National** will no longer be available on this frequency, however you can continue to listen by retuning to either 101.5 FM or 819 AM, that's 101.5 FM or 819 AM. Please tune now and you can continue to listen uninterrupted. You can also still listen to us via the **RNZ** website, rnz.co.nz, **Sky Digital** channel 421, on Freeview channel 50, on **I-Heart Radio**, on your mobile phone through the **RNZ** app. For more information, visit rnz.co.nz/tihiotonga RNZ apologises for any inconvenience caused by this change." David Kaio observed the site still operating at 0330 UTC on 11 July but David Headland was the first member to report the closure when checking the frequencies after 0600 UTC that day. Transmissions from **Sport Nation Invercargill** on 1224 were switched off at 2210 (10.10am Jul 01). The Broadcasting section includes the local Broadcasting Service "**Radio Norfolk**" as well as offshore television services and **ABC** radio services that are retransmitted to the Island. Radio Norfolk transmits in both AM and FM frequencies of 89.9 FM and **1566** AM, and during Island wide power outages, the **1566** AM service will still be operational to serve the community. To supplement the radio budget, a small sponsorship scheme was commenced in 1991 in a format similar to the Australian community stations sponsorship. **Radio New Zealand** World and Pacific News is relayed at 8:30am, Monday to Friday. The Satellite relay is transmitted overnight every night on **1566** AM.

1314 kHz is back and increased to 700 watts and improved sound.

Romania

Since 1 August 2025, all medium wave and long wave transmitters of the **Romanian Broadcasting Corporation (SRR)** have closed down from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Romanian local time. In the morning, however, the MW transmitters appear to be switched on as early as 5:50 AM; the LW already around 5:30 AM. I will investigate this more closely and also monitor when the program sound actually switches on in the morning. Medium wave is the only way to cover the vast, partly mountainous country to every corner. Furthermore, there is a need to serve the Romanian minorities in neighboring countries. At night, the domestic program has been (at least so far) easily received in large parts of Europe.

Our friend and loyal reader Luca Trifan, from **Cluj-Napoca** in Romania, informs us that on Tuesday, 19th, the **Romanian National Audiovisual Council (CNA)** debated **Radio Romania's** decision to reduce the number of **hours of medium and long wave** programming. The Council members emphasised the strategic importance of the medium wave network and expressed their dissatisfaction at the lack of prior warning of such a reduction. An investigation will be carried out into the effects of this reduction and its real impact on listeners. Sanctions could be imposed.

At the same time, the director of **Radiocom**, the state-owned company responsible for maintaining the transmitters, warned that such a reduction, even if temporary, would lead to increased costs for the company, mainly due to personnel costs, as each OM/OL station is served by at least one technician and several guards, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

He estimates that **Radiocom** can bear these additional costs for a few weeks, after which additional funding will be needed. Răzvan Ioan Dincă, the director of **Radio Romania**, justified the reduction with budgetary constraints, the alternative being the elimination of shortwave broadcasting and, consequently, of **Radio Romania International**, as its Internet/satellite audiences are too small to justify its existence without shortwave. Mr Dincă hopes that the MW service will be fully restored as soon as possible, but that this will require additional public funding. The suspension of LW/MW broadcasting between 22:00 and 05:54 GMT+3 is scheduled to last until the end of the year, after which it will be reviewed, subject to an increase in the budget for 2026.

On a more personal note, I am very disappointed by the lack of coverage of this issue in the national press, even on the stations concerned (**Radio România Actualități** and **Radio Antena Satelor**). Fortunately, the CNA's reaction to this situation gives me hope that, at least for **RRA**, the medium wave network will not be abandoned anytime soon, as it is the easiest way to cover at least 99.3% of the entire Romanian population, especially in emergencies. Most people still own a radio capable of receiving it. On the other hand, it is virtually impossible to buy a radio capable of receiving long waves today, and with the increase in maintenance and operating costs, the future of **153 kHz** is uncertain.

Min kontakt Andy på Total Broadcast Solutions har gitt interessant informasjon om AM-sendingene i County Waterford som jeg skrev om i forrige artikkel.

80-tallsstasjonene som stengte ved utgangen av 1988 var:

1026 ABC Tramore, Co. Waterford. Senderen ble ødelagt i en brann i 1998.

1164/1332 Suirside Radio sendte fra The Mall, Waterford.

1197 WLR Carrickpheirish, Waterford brukte opprinnelig T-antenne på mellombølgen. Har siden 1989 gått som lisensiert stasjon fra bl.a. samme site med ID WLR FM¹. (95.1, 94.8, og 97.5 MHz.)

1593-sendingene i 2003 kom fra en eiendom i *Kilmeaden, Co. Waterford*. Call sign var "Radio Caroline", og stasjonen relesendte sendinger produsert i Maidstone studios fra satellitt med hovedfrekvenser på WorldSpace fra 2002 og Astra 28.2°Ø fra februar 2003. Mellombølgesenderen var en RCA ET4335, med en effekt på omtrent 400 w. Av og til ble en hjemmelaget AM Stereo lineær exciter brukt, med 50 w effekt.

1584-sendinger (lisensiert, 2009-) med *Zenith Classic Rock* som callsign kom fra en eiendom i *Ballygorey, Co. Kilkenny*. En Broadcast Electronics BE AM 2.5 kW sender med AM Stereo ble brukt. Kvarthøgeantenne og //FM 103.8 MHz. Stasjonen ble hørt av mange dxere i Skandinavia samtidig som ARCs egen (RKF/BE) 1584 Arctic Radio (Morokulien -Eda/Magnor) sendte i januardagene 2009. En av disse lytterne var GS/Geir Stokkeland² som hørte stasjonen 13.januar 2009 og fikk dette QSL-brevet:

Hi Geir, Yes I can confirm that this is Zenith Classic Rock on 1584 kHz. The DJ at this time was Harry Harrison. Output power was 1 kW and antenna is a 102 degree tall (54m) vertical base fed tower. It was using the C-QUAM AM stereo system.

The station has a temporary licence from Ireland's Broadcasting Commission (BCI). Many thanks for your report, and I thank you for your kind wishes for Zenith.

I use an Icom IC7000 receiver, connected to a long wire antenna (Beverage). I januar 1999 var jeg ombord på Air Canada 857 på vei fra LHR til YYZ . Da den store 747-en passerte Killarney i 10 700 meters høyde annonserte kaptein Bill Snyder fra flight deck: "Flying towards Newfoundland, Iles de la Madeleine, St. Lawrence, Montreal, Ottawa and Toronto, overcast and light snow. Next sight of God's good earth will be Gander, Newfoundland. Enjoy your flight!"

Vi kjørte videre på N72 gjennom *Tralee*⁸, så videre forbi *Kerry Airport*, med *Radio Kerry*⁹ og senere *Clare FM*¹⁰ på bilradioen og via N69/N67 til fergen *Shannon Breeze* ved *Tarbert*¹¹ (*Mouth of the Shannon*) over til *Killimer* og overnatting i *Kilkee*¹², **Co Clare** fulgte hos *Anne Nolan*, på *Nolans B&B* øst for byen. Middagen ble inntatt på *Bar Food* på *The Hideout*.

Kilkee ligger på vestkysten av *Clare* med en befolkning på 1300 og er inngangsporten til halvøya *Loop Head*. Byen har en fin badestrand og mange turister kommer. *County Clare* har mange fortidsminner, som slott, tårn, befestninger, graver, monumenter, og steinkors, samt 150 gamle kirker, 3 katedraler, og 8 klostre,

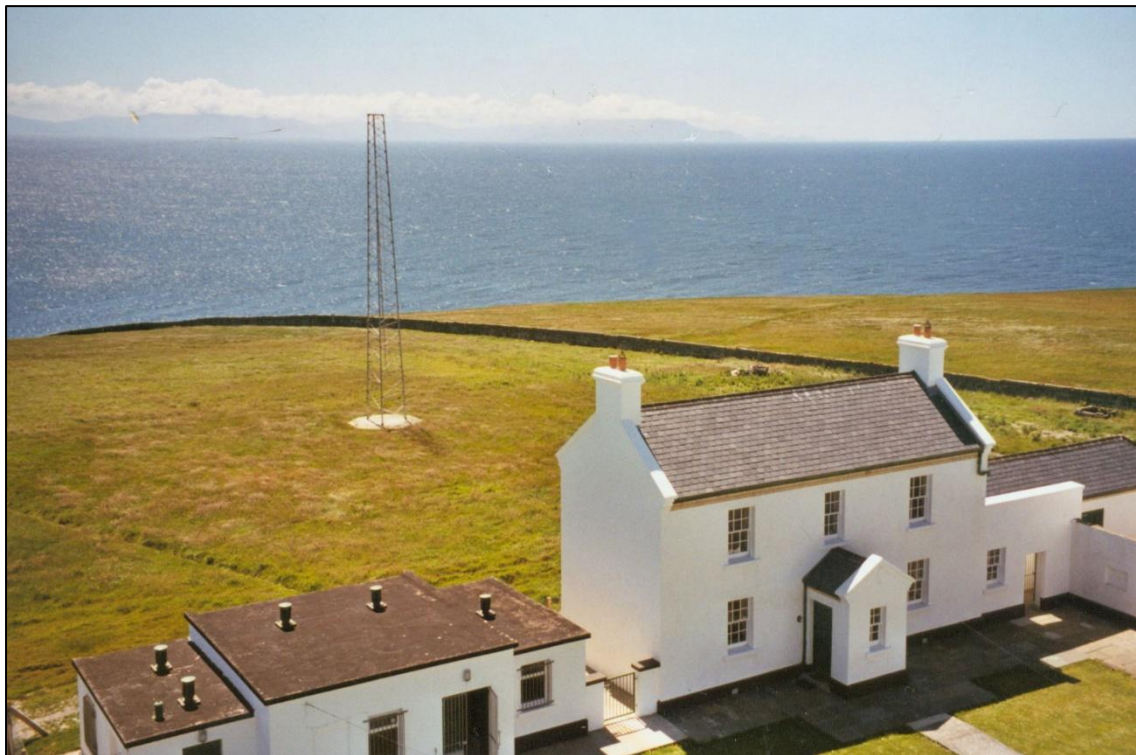

25.juli:

Neste morgen gikk turen først sørover på R487 til Loop Head.¹³ Fyrvokter *Thomas McInerney* skulle ta imot på fyrstasjonen der, men var opptatt. Deretter besøkte vi landsbykirken *Our Lady of Lourdes Church in Cross*, et sterkt møte med den lokale Mariafromheten, med en statue av *Sta Maria Immaculata* utenfor, og mange påminnelser om Marias åpenbaring i Lourdes: *The Mother and Lady of all Nations*. Videre oppover Irlands vestkyst på N67 via *Milltown Malbay*, som ligger ved *Spanish Point*, (gammelt irsk navn *Sraid na Cathrach*, som betyr fortveien.)

Så videre gjennom *Doonbeg* til *Lahinch* og *Liscannor*, deretter entret vi *Cliffs of Moher*, 231m oh, hvor vi gikk opp til toppen av *O'Briens tower*. Herfra så vi *Aran Islands* i *Galway Bay*.¹⁴ Nordover fra klippene kjørte vi forbi *Doolin* (ned R479/R459, med ferge til *Inisheer*, *Aran Islands*, og jeg tror nok begge lokaliseringer kanskje kan være bra steder for radiolytting og DXpeditions.

Deretter gikk ferden gjennom *Lisdoonvarna*, *Toomaghara*, *Ballyvaughan* og så en liten stopp på en bensinstasjon i *Kinvarra*, før vi fortsatte til *Kilcolgan* og kjørte inn på N18. Vi kjørte gjennom *Galway City*, **Co Galway** på *Dublin Road*, ut på *Newcastle Road*, og så nordvestover på N59 via *Moycullen* til *Clifden*, og denne dagens mål: *Seaview B&B* på *Westport Road*, hos *John og Joan Coyne*.

Byen *Clifden* ligger på kysten av *Connemara*, mellom *Atlantehavet*, *12 Ben Mountains* og store myrområder. I *Clifden* landet første fly fra USA til Europa 1911, og herfra sendte *Marconi* telegrafi til *Cappahayden, NL*, som jo lenge har vært et meget kjent QTH for *Dxpeditons*¹⁵, hvor blant annet vår egen *Radio Northern Star* som sender fra *Askøy Kringkaster* ved *Bergen* er hørt med tydelig ID to ganger, både med 70 og 700 watt effekt da stasjonen lå på 1611 kHz.

Middag ble inntatt på *Derryclare Seafood*, der vi imidlertid spiste en delikat *Irish Stew*! Deretter vandret vi i byen, og musikk hørtes fra mange barer, Størst var likevel inntrykkene på en meget Republikansk bar med revolusjonsheltene fra 1916 på veggene. Det var tydelig at vi ble sett litt an, men da vertskapet hørte vi var norske forsvant skepsisen! En lokal artist spilte opp med countrymusikk, bl.a. *Mick Hanly/Hal Ketchum* /*Hellbillies* sin sang *Past the Point of Rescue*. /*Krasafaren Steinbu*.

I pøsregnet etter en fantastisk Irish Stew i Clifden, Co Galway hørte vi kjente og kjære signaler fra Norge på bilradioen ned lokal styrke: 630 LKA NRK P1 Vigra, og 1314 LKS NRK P1/Europakanalen Kvitøy. Det er ufattelig at Norge lot disse flotte senderanleggene gå i bakken! Bilde: SM.

26.juli:

Fra Clifden sentrum tok vi den vakre *Sea View Route* før vi kom inn på N59 igjen, med stopp ved et husflidsenter i *Letterfrack*. Videre kjørte vi forbi forbi *Killary-fjorden*, til stopp i *Westport, Co Mayo*. Herfra tok vi en avstikker via *Ballycrack* og *Bangor* ut R313 til *Belmullet*. Jeg tenkte da jeg så myrområdene før Bangor (*hvor Den Oppstandne Kristus skuer utover landsbygda fra et svært krusifiks*) må være ideelle til mobil radiolytting og lange antenner! Så reiste vi videre N59 til *Sligo Town* via torvkraftverket i *Bellacorrick* (og passerte deretter en radiomast, ex pirat?), og så inn til *Ballina*, hvor 1130 ARW *Alternative Radio West* sendte fra på 80-tallet og ble hørt av undertegnede i Bud Prestegård 1981/1982. *Killala Bay* var neste sted og så ble det overnatting på *Ochillmore House* i *Strandhill, Co Sligo*, hos *Renagh Burns*¹⁶. Samme kveld inntok vi middag på "*The Loft*", bar and restaurant at *MJ Carr's* like ved Sligo jernbanestasjon der nattoget til Dublin akkurat da ble stilt opp.

På bilradioen disse dagene var vi også naturligvis innom så vel 567 RTÉ Radio 1 og 612 RTÉ Radio 2 som de kommersielle kringkasterne i området 95.8 Galway Bay FM i Galway City¹⁷ og MidWest Radio¹⁸ i Ballyhaunis, Co.Mayo, bl.a. 96.1 MHz. Den siste var tidligere ulisensisert og ble ofte hørt i Skandinavia på 1332 kHz på 80-tallet. Begge stasjoner er godt hørbare ved gode FM-forhold mot Irland. Gründeren som startet MidWest, Paul Claffey har vært en av forgrunnsfigurene i kringkasting i Irlands nordvestlige hjørne.

En annen sentral person var Tommy Murphy, som startet alt nevnte ARW, Alternative Radio Ballina, Co Mayo (se mer nedenfor) på 1130 kHz sent i 1980. Tommy sjekket med Gardaí før han slo på senderen, slik at han ikke skapte interferens for dem! *Only in Ireland!* Det sies at Tommy, som kom fra Enniscrone i Co. Sligo var så populær i Ballina at han aldri risikerte noe raid. Senere var Tommy involvert i Castle Radio, Westward Radio og TCR/Twin County Radio, som kom på luften våren 1988 og betjente et stort område i Nord-Mayo og nabofylket Sligo på 95 FM, ble støttet av lokale forretningsmenn og hadde seks heltidsansatte. Tommy ble også hørt på 738 kHz (Independent Radio Mayo) i Castlebar og på Paul Claffeys Midwest Radio både på 1332 og FM. Han døde i 2012. (Forts.)

History of Radio in Costa Rica (72): Radio Alajuela

In 1967, Rubén Herrera Calvo, manager-owner of Ecos de Poas sold the station to Radio Libertad (Series No.52). On the other hand, Herrera established another station Radio Alajuela on August 13, 1967. The station began on 1300 kHz and later changed to 1280 kHz.

The legendary name of “Ecos del Poas” was resumed when they began a news program, “Noticieros Ecos del Poas” starting from December 1, 1978. The program was directed by Gerardo Enrique Fonseca who had been working with Emisoras Columbia.

Av konventrapporten, en hel sida lång, framgår att LR hade med sig flera fina priser till den sedvanliga tävlingen. Vinnare var ZJ (Zet Jacobsson) med OA på andra plats. Klockan 06.15 gick revelj i stuga 18, ty LR skulle checka in på Axamo airport kl 08.00. JP körde honom dit. För övriga var det GJ (Göte Johansson) som väckte kl 0800."

Ja, för en sann ARC-are finns det inga gränser när det gäller att delta i konventen. Undrar om engagemanget är lika stort hos medlemmarna i dag? Nedan ser vi LR på besök hos DX-aren Bruce Reynolds i San Jose, Kalifornien 1981. LR lärde känna Bruce, även han DX-are, när denne jobbade på American Forces Network i Tokyo under militärtjänsten.

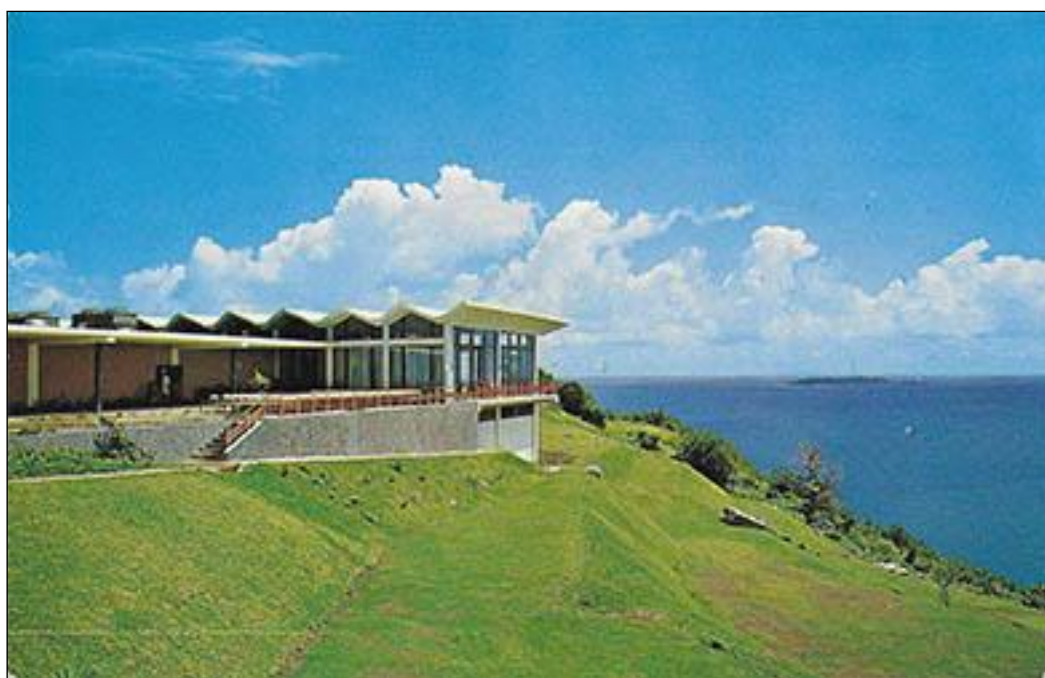

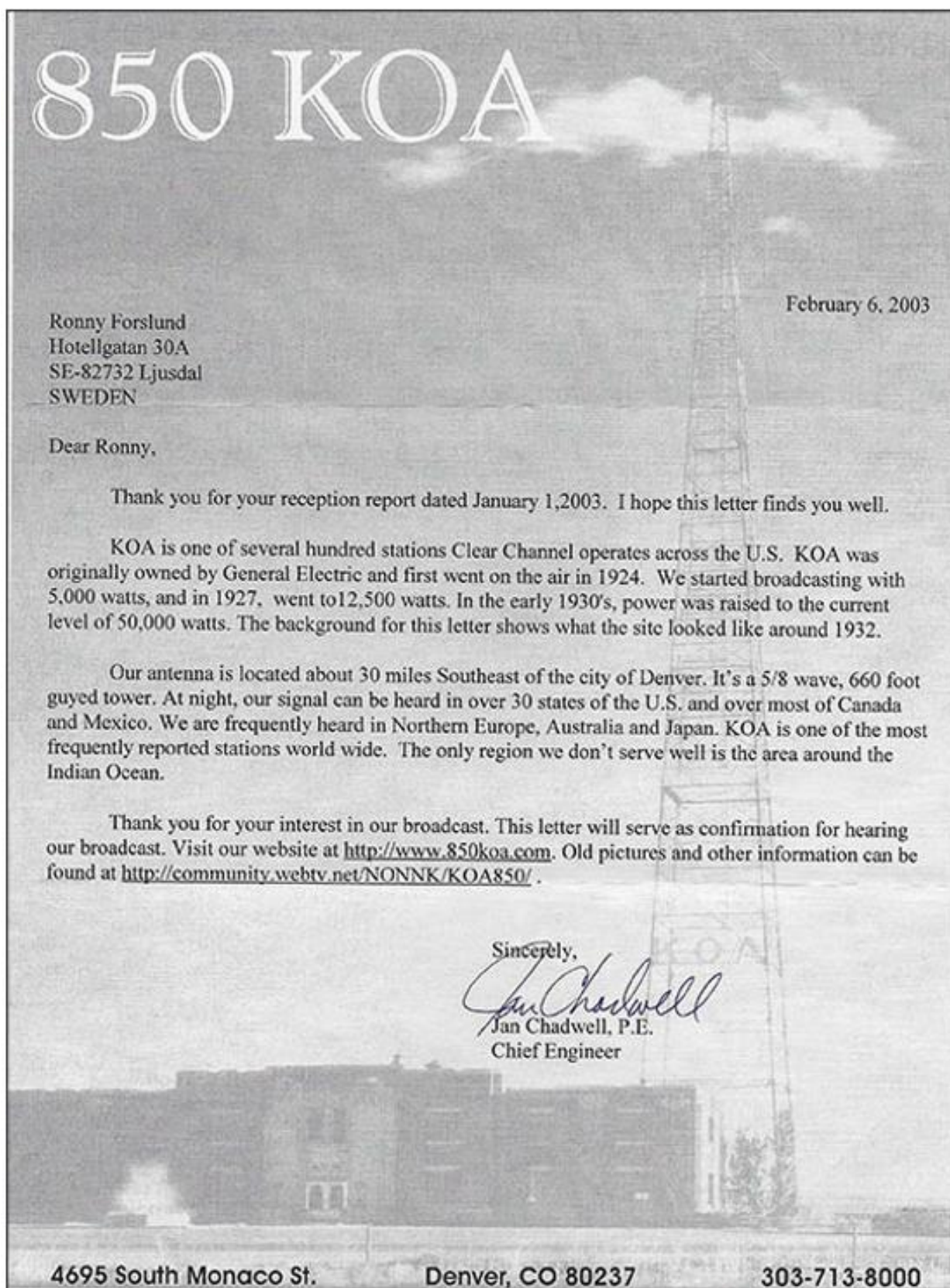

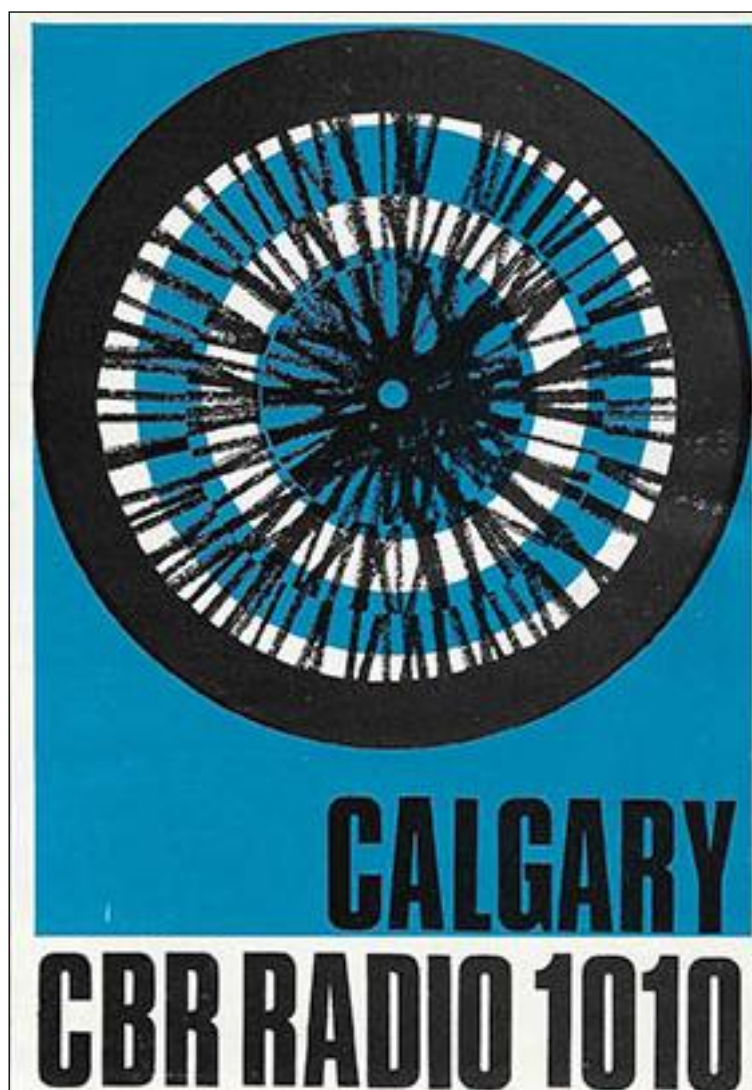
